

# O'NEILL UNOFFICIAL AVERAGE LEADER FOR '81-'82 WITH 214.953

The 1981-1982 season was possibly the highest scoring season in the Nation's Capital history. In all, 83 bowlers had at least one league average over 200. The top 21 bowlers are listed below. For the second straight year, it took a 203 composite average to make the Top Ten. Larry O'Neill is the new average leader, replacing Steve Sipe, who composited 217 in the 1980-1981 season.

To be considered for ranking, a bowler must have bowled at least 160 league games. Of those 160 games, the bowler must have had at least 70 games in one league in his 'home' house and 70 games in a league in another house. For the first time, tournament games were not considered in determining the Top Ten bowlers. These will be the same guidelines to determine the Top Ten bowlers for the 1982-1983 season.
