

RENO BOWLING STADIUM?

The Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority has been presented with a report recommending the go-ahead of a 72-lane national bowling stadium. Construction estimates range from between \$15.4 and \$28.9 million, depending upon whether surface or garage parking is built. It would have seating for 1,000, with an additional 1,000 portable seats available. There would be a restaurant, lounge, squad room, locker room, and a removable raised floor for alternative uses. No timetable on building the stadium was announced, but ABC will celebrate its 100th anniversary in Reno in 1995.
