## Aylor, Brown win MWBPA Award Score Tournament

A 694 series by Graham Aylor and a 569 by Gloria Brown were the winning scores in the 6th annual MWBPA Award Score Tournament held Oct. 4 at Shirley.

Forty-two bowlers participated in this event, which was conducted and sponsored by the Metropolitan Washington Bowling Proprietors' Association. Each man had rolled a game of 298, 299, or 300 in league play at an MWBPA center last season; each woman had rolled a game of 275 or higher.

After the bowling, which was free of charge, the participants were treated to lunch, and then each was called, in order of finish, to select from a table filled with merchandise items with retail prices as high as several hundred dollars.

Aylor selected first and chose a 20-inch television set. Brown chose a Rhino Pro bowling ball.
