
Silver Spring team wins Great Auto Shootout

YORK, Pa. — Third time in the WSBA Team Classic's Great Auto Shootout proved to be the real charm for Billy Clark and Bad Finger of Silver Spring.

Bad Finger captured the first prize of four 1992 Pontiac Lemans and \$2,000 by edging Us Again of Greenbelt 4,779 to 4,750. Clark's teammates were Brian Poole, Brian Hoflich, and William Drumheller.
