
Hayward, Whyte win in Winchester; head to National Seniors Tourney

Two local bowlers will compete in the National Seniors Tournament as a result of their capturing all events titles at the 11th annual Virginia State Seniors Tournament in Winchester.

NCABA Past President Ralph Hayward of Temple Hills (Class C, age 60-64 — 1,233 scratch/1,353 handicap) and James Whyte of Wheaton (Class D, age 55-59 — 1,175/1,313) will travel to Corpus Christi, Tex., for the May 2-3 competition on the ABC Tournament lanes. Both bowlers also earned top honors elsewhere: Hayward was first in "C" singles (621/681) to earn \$115.85; Whyte scored 612 with Karl

Kuller to take top honors in doubles (1,298 total), \$400.
