
Papee, Perry top winners at RT's Junior Classic at Dale City

Supachai Papee of Alexandria and Joey Perry of Woodbridge were divisional champions at RT's Junior Classic, presented by the Sport Plus/Carmen Don Pro Shop and held April 11 at Dale City.

Papee, the top qualifier in the Scratch Division with 842 for four games, scored 180-220-236 in match play and won two matches (worth 40 bonus pins) to total 1,518 and win a \$500 scholarship.

Bethesda's David Eisenberg tallied 1,404 (823 scratch/561 match play/20 bonus pins) to win a \$250 scholarship. He was followed by Christine Martin of Huntingtown, Md., 1,402 (811/571/20), who received a Meteor Flash ball and Mark Spires of Waldorf, 1,384 (770/574/40), who collected a Zebra Too ball.

Eric Kennedy of the District finished third with 821 (717) to collect a \$50 gift certificate, while Christina Fuller of Port Republic, Md., 813 (433) took home a \$40 gift certificate for fourth place.
