
Akers and Moore win VIR-MAR 600 Club Winter Doubles Tourney

Two Herndon residents, Josh Akers, 18, a student at NOVA (624 series), and Kevin Moore, 17, a senior at Herndon High (571), combined for a 1,195 series to win the VIR-MAR DISTRICT 600 Club Winter Doubles Tournament at AMF Alexandria on February 14.

Hyattsville's Renee Parker, 20, a sophomore at PGCC (591), and Suitland's Anthony Wheeler, 18, a freshman at Morgan State University (558), scored 1,149 to earn second-place honors. Mike Herman, 16, a sophomore at Woodbridge High (578), and Andrew Campbell, 16, a Gar-Field High sophomore (567), totaled 1,145 for the third-place award.

The high team game award went to Herman (228 game) and Campbell (254) with 482; Akers (259) and Moore (163) earned the second high game award with 422.
