# The Mini Eliminator Today

### Peterson Blasts Huge 564 To Dominate Wednesday Super Mini Sweeper



Vernon Peterson set an all-time Super Bowl record for sweeper scoring Wednesday evening at the Super Mini. The former Mini Eliminator Champion from Dearborn Heights, Michigan rolled games of 299 and 265 for an enormous 564 to win the \$3000 top prize.

Peterson's margin of victory was also the most ever, 75 pins ahead of second place. In that second spot with a 489 was another great bowler Jeremy 'Mr. 900' Sonnenfeld, Sioux Falls, SD. 33 players cashed from a field of 177.

### 2003 Super Mini Draws Largest International Contingent

For 20 year old Mikhail Pozniakov, Moscow, Russia, it's his first Mini Eliminator tournament and only his second trip to the United States. It's also his first time in Las Vegas.

A member of the Russian National Bowling Team, Mikhail is the first Russian bowler to ever compete in a Mini Eliminator event, and he hopes the experience will make him a better player in events closer to his home.

Pozniakov is also a member of the Avtoritet Bowling Club in Russia and won the Avtoritet Cup last year. In that event he won \$10,000 which helped finance his trip to this event.

"I'm here to win of course, but also to get more experience against some very good players," he said. Pozniakov does most of his bowling at the Miami Bowling Center in Moscow, and his team competes in about eight ranking tournaments per year. Pozniakov has been bowling only four years and hopes to become one of Europe's best bowlers.

The largest contingent of international players in this year's Mini hails from Germany, Austria, Italy and the Netherlands. The group was organized by German pro shop owner Peter Wolfschaffner, and includes over 50 players, many of them some of the best in Europe.

In all, over 100 international players are entered and don't be surprised if you see many of them on the finals prize list.
