## Haynes Wins First 2003 Super Bowl Mini Sweeper



David Haynes, Las Vegas rolled a huge 534 to win the first 2003 Super Bowl Mini Eliminator Sweeper Monday evening here at the Gold Coast Bowling Center.

Haynes, bowling in the 8 p.m. squad, rolled games of 256 and 278 to surpass the 513 posted in the 6 p.m. squad by 2001 Mini Eliminator champion Derek Sapp, Keokuk, Iowa. Haynes earned \$3,000 for the victory, and Sapp collected \$1750 for his runner-

up finish.

David Ewald, Warren, Michigan, winner of the 2002 Mini Eliminator, finished third with a big 509 to earn \$1500. Rounding out the top five were Chad Nelson, Owatonna, Minnesota with a 508 and Ken Muscato, Canadaigua, New York with a 504. Nelson cashed for \$1250, and Muscato took home \$1000.

The first sweeper of this event drew 190 entries with 33 bowlers cashing.
