HIGHLIGHTS

This was the largest and highest scoring senior tournament ever held in the Washington, DC Area. Over 360 area senior bowlers participated in the tournament with averages ranging from 84 to 223 and ages from 55 to 92. There were 78 teams, 184 doubles, 362 singles and 298 all events. The handicap was 100% of 220, and the prize ratio was at least one prize for each eight entries. All bowlers who rolled four strikes in a row received a 4-Bagger emblem. Also, a Senior Tournament pin was given to all bowlers who had a 200 game. New bowlers to the tournament received the WDCAWBA/NCABA Senior Tournament pin.

Biggest money winner was Frederick A. Renninger with \$304.00 (Team – 93.50, Doubles 92.50, Singles 76.00 and All events 42.00) followed by Orland A. VanBavel with \$273.50 (Team 93.50, Doubles 43.00, Singles 97.00 and All events 40.00).
