

Bell-Glover team wins 600-700 Scratch Doubles Tourney at Bull Run

(692) & Stacey Gonzales (665), 1,357, \$160; and 5, Cathy Bock, Jeffersonton, Va. (666) & Stephen Hahn (678), 1,344, \$50.

Mark Glover earned an additional \$90 for capturing the Men's Singles with his 782 on games of 279-247-256. Others: 2, Kilinia Rhone, Temple Hills (707), \$45; 3, Joe Tremper, Laurel (695), \$25; and 4, Bobby Jones (692), \$15.

Meanwhile, Michelle Mullally won the \$90 first prize in Women's Singles with her 742 (237-248-257). Stacey Gonzales placed second with 694 to earn \$45, ahead of Tiffany Bell (690), \$25; and WDCAWBA Hall of Famer Dawn Fay, Manassas (681), \$15.
