Derwin Pitre, Lafayette, Louisiana was the morning leader in the 39 and under division with a 688.

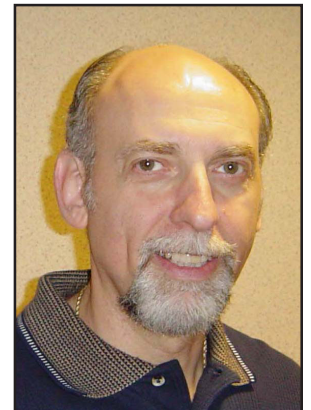

The 40-49 leader on Monday was **Mike Marks**, Elmira, NY with a 673 to lead the morning. The afternoon

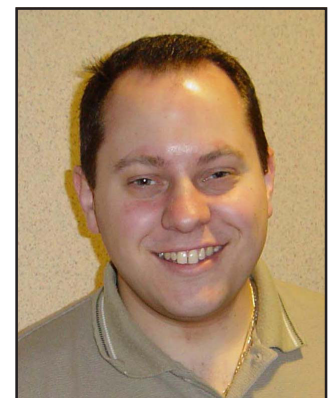
leader was **Chris Porcello**, Carson City, Nevada. Chris shot a 649.
