#### **Ray Cyr Rolls 300-547 To Win Mini Eliminator Bonus Event**

The first Super Bowl Mini Eliminator FREE Bonus Tournament was an overwhelming success, with 912 entries in the eight two-game squads held over three days, starting Super Bowl Sunday.

Ray Cyr, New Hartford, New York waited until the final squad of the no entry fee event Tuesday night, then rolled 300 his first game, which meant he only needed a 201 to beat the posted high score of 500 after seven squads. Moving to the opposite end of the center, he had a closing 247 to win the \$3000 with a great 547 total. The perfect game was the third of the event thus far.

"I had other events to bowl and just couldn't make it over to the Orleans before tonight, and I didn't get here in time to bowl the first squad," said Cyr. He used a Brunswick Absolute Inferno to win the event.

Fero Williams, Gardena, California

finished second for \$2000 with a big 526. Third was Bo Goergen, Sanford, Michigan with a 523 for \$1500. 4th and 5th went to Ryan Boyd, Plantation, Florida and Billy Oatman, Chicago with scores of 512 and 511. They won \$1250 and \$1000.

Mark Siders, Columbus, Ohio rolled a 500 on the first day that stayed in first place until the final squad. In that squad, he beat his own score with a 510, but five other players beat it by more, so Siders had to settle for 6th and 7th place for a total of \$1075.

101 bowlers cashed in the \$20,000 event. It took a score of 440 to make the list of cashers.
