Lang Takes \$5000 Dynorooz Friday Sweeper

Michigan wins again. Brunswick Absolute Inferno wins again. Jay Lang, Sterling Heights, Michigan won the \$5000 Dynorooz sweeper Friday night by defeating local star Paul Enright of Henderson 213-208 in the title match.

Lang had the match well in hand until leaving a 7-10 in the ninth and a 4-6 in the tenth to open the door for Enright. Paul stepped up needing a double in the 10th to win. He got the first strike, then left a stone seven pin on his second toss, and had to settle for the \$2500 runner-up

check.

"I really thought I blew it," said Lang, "I'm fortunate to win after the way I finished." He averaged 219 for his 8-0 record, and won some close matches. He knocked out his friend David Ewald, who won Wednesday night's sweeper with the Absolute Inferno in round five. In round six he beat another Las Vegas star in a high scoring match, topping Paul Renteria 256-234.

264 bowlers entered the \$50,000+ sweeper, another sell out.
