- Scott Williams now leads the 20 and 15-year lists in games bowled. Scott has only missed five nights of bowling the last sixteen seasons and has had perfect attendance in fourteen of the twenty years he has bowled in the Commercial League.
- With yet another season with perfect attendance, Dave Chittum continues to lead the 10 -year and 5 -year lists in games bowled. Dave has missed one night in the last thirteen years and is the only bowler with perfect attendance the last five years.

## SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

This year's division winners (team \# 1 and team \#18) had the highest scratch and handicap team game averages in their respective divisions. That's the first time that has happened since we went to the two division format. Both teams also benefitted from the fact that their opponents' scoring average against them was not the best. Team \# 1's opponent's average was 12 th highest (or next to last in 'A'), and team \#18's opponents' average was tenth best in 'B'. So once again it appears that the key to winning a division is to both bowl well and be fortunate enough to catch opposing teams at less than their best.

Team \#11 is a good example of why I think our current format gives everyone a fair chance. Although team \#11 had the lowest scratch team average in the league, the $100 \%$ handicap provision allows them to compete on an equal footing and they finished third in ' $A$ '. The fourth place finishers in each division, team \# 5 in ' $A$ ' and team \#22 in 'B', provide further proof that you don't have to be one of the higher averaging teams to be competitive.

Year after year, the opponent's team average is a key predictor as to where a team finishes in the standings. Just ask team \#14 or team \# 2. Team \#14 had the highest opponent's average shot against them in ' $A$ ' and finished in 10th place. Team \# 2 also seemed to hit the hot teams a lot this year and finished next to last in 'A'. The same thing held true in 'B'. Team \#25 had the misfortune of having the highest opponent's average shot against them in 'B' and finished in 12th place as a result.

## THE SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2006-2007 Commercial League season will be remembered for the closure of BAFC in mid-February and having to finish out the season at BA Fairfax. It will also be remembered for one of the best championship matches in league history between team \# 1, Bowl America Gaithersburg, and team \#18, Scarfcheesi XXI - in a season in which both division winners completed worst-to-first comebacks. Following is a recap of how those two teams got to the week 35 title match.

## DIVISION 'A' RACE

The ' $A$ ' race started out with a different leader each of the first four weeks (teams \#14, \# 4, \#12 and \# 8) before settling down somewhat. Team \# 8, Freaktastic Four, held the lead for seven consecutive weeks before team \#12 took over the top spot again in week 11, staying in first through week \#15. Team \# 3, The 10th Pin, was in first place after week 16 - the only week they were to lead the division all year. Team \# 1, Bowl America Gaithersburg, recovered from a terrible start to the season (they were dead last in 'A' after week 5) and moved into the ' $A$ ' lead for the first time in week 17. Team \#12 regained the lead the next week (week 18) for one last time before team \# 1 took the lead for good in week 19. By the time the league moved to Fairfax after week 24, Tragert's boys had opened up a 63 -point lead. A red-hot Chris Durst played a major role in making sure team \# 1's lead was never in jeopardy after that. In fact, the lead was never less than 42 points the rest of the way. Team \#12 won 26.5 points in week 34 's position round to finish in second place in 'A'.

## DIVIVION 'B' RACE

The ' $B$ ' race was the opposite of the ' $A$ ' race in that it went right down to the end of week 34's position round match before a winner was declared. Team \#15 led the division each of the first two weeks before team \#28, Sports Plus/Carmen Don, took over for a three-week reign in weeks three thru five. Team \#22, I.H.N.I., was the 'B' leader in weeks six thru nine, giving up the lead to team \#15 in their head-to-head showdown in week 10. Team \#15 then held the ' $B$ ' lead for the next seventeen weeks (weeks 10 thru 26) and led by as much as 61 points at one point (after week 18). Team \#18, Scarfcheesi XXI, moved into the lead for the first time in week 27, completing their own worst-to-first move (they were in last place in 'B' after week 9). Team \#16 sparred with team \#18 the rest of the way as the two teams went back and forth with the lead the next seven weeks. Team \#18 was in first in weeks 27, 28, 29 and 32 while team \#16 held the lead after weeks 30, 31 and 33 . The Scarfcheesi boys won just enough in week 34 's head-to-head match to win the division by 1.5 points over team \#16.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

Another Commercial League year is in the books. This was the first season where there was no limit for team entering average and, although the two highest averaging teams won the two divisions, our league format still allows lower average teams to compete on a level playing field with the higher average teams. It is reasonable to expect that next year's format will remain the same.

As has often been pointed out, it will take everyone's cooperation/assistance to add more teams next year. So, how about it - let's all do our share in making that happen. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for the 2007-2008 season.
