Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Don Freeman leads the 30-year list in games bowled having bowled seventeen more games than runner-up John Cover over that time frame.
- Scott Williams leads the 25-year and 20-year lists in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, giving him a total of only eight missed nights of bowling the last twenty seasons and twelve missed nights in the last twenty-five years. He has had perfect attendance in eighteen of the twenty-five years he has bowled in the Commercial League.
- Dave Chittum had another season with perfect attendance and leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5-year list with Luis Pinto. Dave has missed only one night in the eighteen years he has bowled in the Commercial League (he started in the 1994-95 season) and has perfect attendance the last twelve seasons. Dave, Luis, and Richard Ernst (who missed one game, but was here each week) are the only bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.

2011-12 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

A total of eighteen bowlers maintained a perfect attendance record during the year, nine from `A' and nine from `B'. Participation in pre-bowled and postbowled matches counts towards perfect attendance.

Congratulations to team #15, Bowling For Soop, as they picked a good week to roll the season's high team series scratch (a 2851) against team # 8, Eight Is Enough, in the final night's feature match. Team #15 went 30-2 in what turned out to be a rather lop-sided league championship match. The match between the two second place teams was also not very close, although team #17, Wild Turkeys, did lose seven points and was down 83 pins to team # 7 after the first game. But team #17 recovered in games two and three, winning by 105 pins and 210 pins, respectively, and ended up winning 23 points. Kudos to each of the top four teams on their success this season!

Andrew Blackmore's 289 game and 785 series were the high scratch game and set in the final week and earned Andrew star-of-the-week honors at 140 pins over average. The overall league average on the last night was 203.7 and there were a total of eight 700 series. After Andrew's 785 came Albert Utterback 759, Chhoeun To 754, Joey Havens 740, Willie Williams 739, Chris Blackmore 735, Rich Lucey 722 and Chris Chittum 717.

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

To end up as the Commercial League champions, your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. It is common place to see some of the top teams with the lowest opponent's average bowled against them. Similarly, some of the bottom finishing teams seem to have hit the hot teams more than their fair share. As a case in point, this year in division A, team # 8, Eight Is Enough, won the division while having the lowest opponents average rolled against them. Likewise, team # 7 came in second in the division and had the next to lowest opponent's average bowled against them. The same holds true for the 'B' side where the division winners (and eventual league champions) team #15, Bowling For Soop, had the next to lowest opponent's average bowled against them. And even with the use of a six-man roster, team #15 had the highest team scratch average in the league. Having the best team scratch average and one of the lowest opponent's average bowled against them proved to be a winning combination.

So once again the stats confirm that, yes, you have to bowl well to have a chance to win, but it is also helpful if you are fortunate enough to avoid the hot teams week in and week out.

THE 2011-2012 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2011-2012 season will be remembered for down to the wire finishes in each division and also for Joey Havens' league and house record 867 series that he rolled on April 4th, 2012. Following is a recap of how this season's divisional races unfolded.

DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season the 'A' division had five different teams that held first place. Team #10, Drunk Monkeys, held first place for just the first week. Team # 5, Pin-a-tration, took over first in week two, gave it up to team # 6, Myer Connex, in week three, but regained the lead and held it in weeks four through seven. In week eight, team # 8, Eight Is Enough, took over the 'A' lead and stayed at the top almost the rest of the way - leading by as many as 59 points (week sixteen). The only week team # 8 wasn't in first the rest of the way was in week twenty-eight when team # 7 took the 'A' lead by a single point. But team # 8 won big the next week and team # 7 was unable to sustain their momentum. Team # 7 did have one last shot at winning the 'A' title in their week 34 divisional position round against team # 8, but team # 8 prevailed in that key match 22-10. Both teams ended up losing their week 35 matches against their 'B' opponents and ended up finishing overall second and fourth, respectively.

DIVISION 'B' RACE

The 'B' division only had four different teams in first place during the year. Team #12, Tucking Fenpins, started the year off at the top after week one, and then was in first place just one other week during the season (at the half-way point after week seventeen). Team #19, Controlled Chaos, showed a lot of early speed in 'B' as they held first place from weeks two through ten including a 36-point lead after week six - which was the largest lead in 'B' that any team enjoyed all year. In week eleven, team #17, Wild Turkeys, took over the 'B' top spot and held it for twenty of the next twenty-one weeks. The one week exception was team #12's brief one-week stay at the top after week seventeen. However, team #15, Bowling For Soop, ended up overtaking team #17 when they bowled each other in week 32, a match in which team #15 won 25 points. Team #15 never looked back from that point and won the division title by a 22-point margin. As it turned out, team #15 was saving their best for last, shooting the season's high team scratch score in the championship match against team # 8 (a story recapped on page 12) to become the 2011-2012 Commercial League champions.

SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

As has often been pointed out, it will take everyone's cooperation/assistance to add more teams next year. As of right now, we have three teams not returning and I have input on one new team and several individual bowlers wanting to join next season. We obviously have room for lots more. So, how about it - let's all work towards expanding the league. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for next season.
