BVL debuts new video

Mary Harrar selected as new BVL executive director

BVL now has a [new video](#) available that movingly tells the BVL story—one of rich history and tradition, the sport of bowling's promise to America's veterans, and a call to take up the cause. With this three-minute video, produced by Ten Pin Marketing, volunteers and potential contributors now have a powerful tool to share with their audiences.

"We want to get this video into the hands of every association leader, bowling center manager, and community volunteer out there," says BVL Board Chairman John LaSpina. In addition to her extensive knowledge of the bowling industry, Harrar has long been an avid BVL supporter coordinating very successful fund-raising campaigns over the years.

Founded in 1942, BVL is a national 501 (c) (3) charity that is consistently acknowledged for efficient and effective programming delivered with extremely low overhead. BVL has been recognized as one of "America's Best Charities," earned a "Top Rated" Nonprofit distinction, and accepted into the Combined Federal Campaign (#93325).

HALL OF FAME BILL GROVER DIES

Bill Grover, a Past President and Hall of Fame member, died May 23. He was 66. Grover, who joined the association's board of directors in 1994, served as president during the 2004-2005 season while many decisions were made regarding the merger of the three local bowling associations -- Nation's Capital Area, Washington, D.C. Area Women's, and Vir-Mar District YABA -- into today's Nation's Capital Area USBC Association. He served as a youth coach at Bowl America Burke for more than 10 years and was active in creating a Club Bowling program at George Mason, where he taught a course in bowling. He was a member of the Hall of Fame's "Class of 2006."

Be aware of the limitations of an Adult Basic membership

The summer league season is getting started, and the dues are \$21 for full membership or \$11 for an Adult Basic membership. If you purchased a full or standard membership last fall, you are covered for the summer and eligible for local awards. Adult Basic memberships are *only good for the league through which they are purchased*, and such members are only eligible for our "bonus awards" program.

The 2015-2016 fall season is almost over for most and finished for some, and I hope you had an enjoyable bowling season. This time of year, the office phone tends to ring quite a bit with questions about prize funds, prize list winners, forfeit situations, and a host of other bothersome situations. Remember to enforce your league rules, and most of the problems will go away. If not, give us a call, and we will do our best to help you work it out.

The [NCAUSBCA 71st Annual Women's Championship Tournament](#) extended entry deadline is June 8, so please be sure to submit your entries. It will be held at Potomac Lanes on Bolling AFB and begins June 18 for two weekends.

The Awards Committee is currently working on the 2016-2017 awards program, so please send your suggestions to president@ncausbca.org before June 5, 2016. As a reminder, the awards program is funded by the lottery fund-rais-

ers. Results for the current version are posted on our Facebook page at facebook.com/ncausbca, and if you have liked us on Facebook, you will receive updates on this and other association newsworthy events. You also can find out who your lane rep is from the listing on the association page and request that he/she present awards to your league members. It is the rep's duty to attend your league organization meetings to help you craft league rules and head off problems.

The USBC Convention recently concluded in Las Vegas, and a report appears on page 12. NCAUSBCA sent nine delegates (elected at our 2015 Annual Meeting) this year, and their views on the workshops, convention, etc., will be posted on our site for you to read. The convention is where some of the decisions are made that affect your bowling life, i.e., membership dues, rules, equipment, awards. The delegates vote on these issues, and at least delegates from NCAUSBCA are directed to vote in the same manner as did a majority of the attendees at our Annual Meeting—a reason why it's important to attend this meeting. In some other associations, the delegates vote what they think is best for their bowlers.

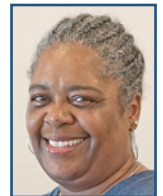

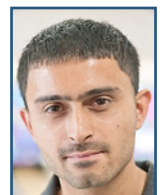

In the NCAUSBCA 71st Annual Open Championship Tournament, "Crofton One" of Edgewater, Md., which included Jesse Sheperdson (611), Cindy Beall (652), Darren Short (690), Anthony Winston (714), and Robert Rowe III (704), took home the Team title by 209 pins.

Meanwhile, "Them" of Alexandria, Va., consisting of James Miller (674), Warner DeVore (663), Nicholas Dean (575), William Bell (664) and Mana Rodbhajan (742), captured the Scratch Team crown.

Sonja Debrew (762) of Temple Hills, Md., and Warren Wiggins (746) of Randallstown, Md., scored 1,624 to win the Doubles title. A 1,514 total by Daniel Dyson of Herndon, Va., and Glenn Grundy of Leesburg, Va., was tops in the Scratch Doubles.

Darell Gillespie of Bowie Md., is the Singles winner, having tallied 873 on a scratch series of 801.

Joshua Keller of Springfield, Va., took home the Scratch Singles crown with 804.

Tracy Montague of Upper Marlboro, captured All Events with his 2,367 total.

Marcus Bell of District Heights, Md., won the Scratch All Events category with 2,172, averaging 241.33 for nine games.

In the optional senior events, Frederick Smith of Greenbelt, Md., won the 50-59 Singles, Glenard Hodges of Temple Hills, Md., the 60+ Singles, and Noel Dysart of Adelphi, Md., the 50+ All Events.

USBC delegates approve dues cap increase

LAS VEGAS – Delegates voted to increase the national dues cap and also voted on three board positions as the 2016 United States Bowling Congress Convention and Annual Meeting concluded April 29 at The Orleans.

Delegates approved bylaws amendments allowing national dues to increase up to a maximum of \$15, and also approved amendments requiring non-merged local and non-merged state associations to be merged by Aug. 1, 2018. They rejected an amendment to allow state associations to have delegates for affiliate associations. Bylaws amendments required two-thirds

of the voting delegates to approve to pass.

Leading up to the USBC Convention, the USBC board asked associations to support the dues cap increase amendment and set a schedule if it was approved—national dues will not increase for the 2016-2017 season, national dues would increase to \$13 for the 2017-2018 season, and national dues would not increase again before the 2022-2023 season.

USBC ANNUAL MEETING LEGISLATIVE RESULTS

Delegates also approved a tournament rule amendment requiring bowlers to report any previous tournament adjustment/rerate unless tournament rules state otherwise but rejected two league rule amendments. League and tournament amendments required a majority vote to pass.

Five candidates ran for the three open positions on the USBC board. Elected for three-year terms were current USBC President Frank Wilkinson of Staten Island, New York, incumbent director Mark Martin of Waterford, Michigan, and Jeffrey Ussery of Tonganoxie, Kansas, all who were slated by the USBC Nominating Committee.

NCAUSBCA Hall of Famer Kendra Gaines of Orlando, Florida, also will join the board for the 2016-2017 season. Gaines, the general manager at Aloma Bowl and a former Team USA member, was elected by Team USA athletes earlier this year. She replaces Andrew Cain, who termed out this year.

The International Bowling Campus Youth Committee members also were determined earlier this year. Melissa McDaniel Morrow of Raleigh, North Carolina, who served as the chair of the IBC Youth Committee last season, was approved by the boards of the Bowling Proprietors' Association of America and USBC for a new three-year term. Morrow will be joined on the IBC Youth Committee by Chrissie Kent of Newark, New Jersey, and Kelly Marlin of Murfreesboro, Tennessee.

During the convention, Bowl for the Cure® and Bowlers to Veterans Link (BVL) presentations highlighted USBC's support of charitable causes during the last year.

BVL, which provides recreation-

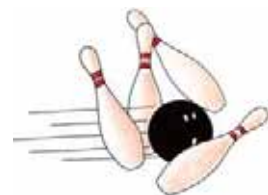

Sticky approaches; fixing your game this summer

Q. *The lanes where I bowl league have very sticky approaches, and it is really hard on my knees. We have told the center personnel, but they don't seem to care. What can I do to help the situation?*

A. Since the advent of synthetic lanes and approaches, this has come up many times before. There are a few things you can do to help yourself. You can buy shoes with interchangeable slide soles. Most of the bowling shoe companies make them; ask your pro shop operator.

Also, you can buy a slide sock;

these slip over your slide sole. They are a bit on the slippery side, but after you get used to them, it makes all approaches virtually the same. I have many friends who use slide socks, and they swear by them. Do not use talcum powder ever; this is a danger to all the other players.

There is a product called Easy Slide, and if you try this, do so with extreme caution, as this can be almost as bad as the powder. If you do use this, use a very small amount and work it into the sole of your shoe; you don't want to transfer it to the approach.

Q. *I am a 190-average bowler and want a new ball that will hook more and give me a good read of the conditions. What would you recommend?*

A. This is a hard question for me to answer for a couple of reasons. First, I have no idea what kind of game you have—how much turn you have or how hard you throw the ball. I would need at least this much information to even guess at what ball might work for your game.

Secondly, I am a member of the Roto Grip amateur staff and because of that affiliation, I naturally would recommend a Roto Grip ball. There may be other bowling balls that could work for you, but my knowledge of them is limited.

I will tell you that my favorite ball for myself right now is the Roto Grip Hy-Wire, a hybrid reactive cover stock. That is a combination of pearl and solid reactive material. This allows the ball to go through the heads clean, it has a good mid-lane read and stores energy for a hard back-end reaction.

I throw the ball at about 16+ speed at release, have what would be called a medium amount of revolutions, and I average in the 215 range. I am 74 years old. This gives you some comparison numbers to your own game.

The Hybrid ball is more controllable on more shots than either Pearl or Solid.

Q. *I did not have a very good bowling season this year. Do you have any ideas I can put to use this summer that will help me to get my game back in order for next season?*

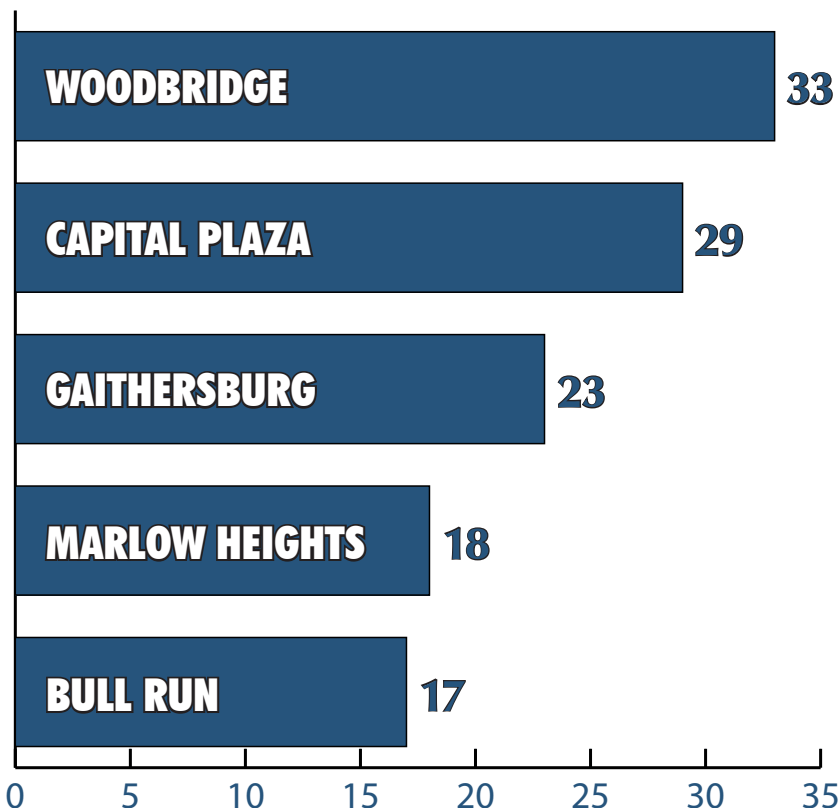

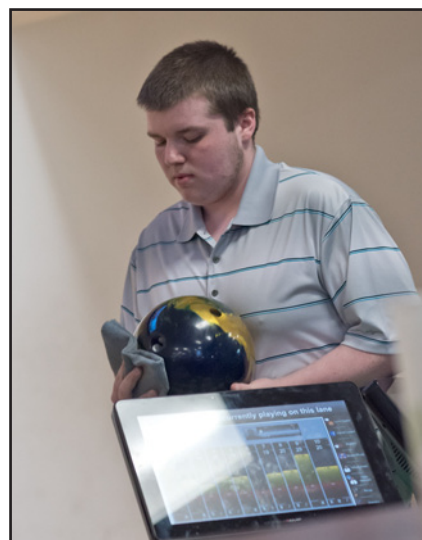

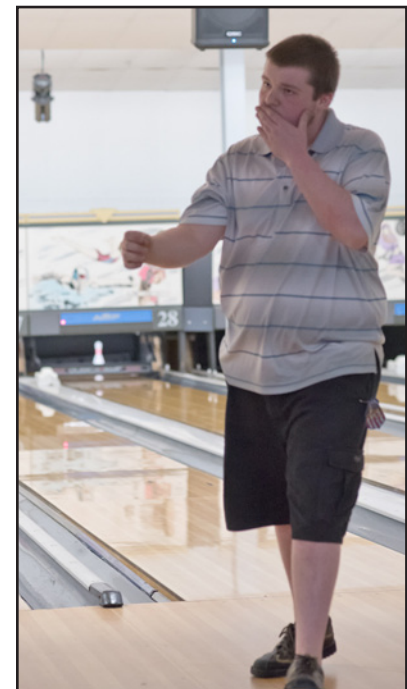
