Glass Repeats As Brunswick Senior World Open Champion

Bob Glass, Lawrence, Kansas made it back-to-back Brunswick Senior World Open crowns November 20 by defeating Mark Roth 224-189 in the championship match at the Orleans Bowling Center in Las Vegas.

Glass started the title match with a double, then left a 4-pin and a 2-pin in the third and fourth. Roth left the 3-6-10 to open the match, then left a ten pin in the second and a swishing 7-10 split in the third. He then bounced back with three strikes in frames 4, 5, and 6, but Glass got his own turkey in frames 5, 6, and 7.

Glass remained clean the rest of the match. Roth struck in the eighth, and then left a 4-7-10 split in the ninth, taking the pressure off for Glass to claim the title. Glass earned \$20,000 for the win, with Roth earning \$15,000.

"I'm stunned I won this year. I prefer the longer format we had last year, and I usually don't do as well in this shorter matchplay format. I wasn't nervous bowling Mark, because he usually comes out on top. I was actually more nervous bowling

Henry Gonzalez before the stepladder. In that match, we both knew one of us would be the number one seed with a \$15,000 guarantee and the other would go home with \$3000," said Glass.

In matches leading up to the title match, Roth defeated Al Sanford 204-184, and Gene Stus 230-224. In the Stus match, Roth closed with a five bagger, forcing Stus to strike in the 10th. Stus then left a 4-6-7 in the 10th to fall by six pins. Sanford earned \$5,000 with \$10,000 going to Stus.

This second annual event drew 182 of the best pro and amateur bowlers in the world. Over \$200,000 was paid in main and side event prize money. The 2003 Senior World Open was a Pinnacle Events Tournament presented by Brunswick and sponsored by Coast Casinos, Turbo 2-N-1 Grips, KR Strikeforce and Kegel's Million, the all new team tournament for 2004 in Florida.
