## Glass Rolls 300, Wins Seven Matches To Take Over Senior World Open Lead

Bob Glass, Lawrence, Kansas, had a great day Thursday. Going into the day, he was 300 pins behind leader Rohn Morton. At the end of the day, he was more than 200 pins ahead of the field.

"I caught a lot of breaks today," said Dr. Glass. The former University of Kansas economics professor won seven of his eight matches in the first round of matchplay, averaging 238 for eight games and earning 210 bonus points, and those are good numbers in anybody's book. "You don't catch guys like Morton and Neff without getting a few breaks," he said. "They are great bowlers."

While Glass was getting breaks, he was also bowling very well, and both Morton and Neff had the opposite type of day. Neff won only three matches in the first round, and Morton won only one, but they held on to second and third place behind Glass. Mark Roth went 5-3 in matchplay to earn the 4th place spot, and John Handegard split his matches 4-4 to finish in 5th after round one.

Glass rolled a 300 and a 279 to anchor his round, and feels good about his game going into the final day of this

event. "I haven't had a day as good as this one in a long time," he said, "and since I

don't bowl too well on TV, I'm happy this format doesn't include a stepladder finals. I really didn't bowl well until today. I skipped the sweepers and didn't feel good in practice, but now I'm looking forward to the last two rounds. I hope I can keep it going." Glass also earned a \$100 bonus for the perfect game.

Matchplay rounds start at 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. With 16 games to go, it's getting really exciting here at the Brunswick Senior World Open!
