Galzerano scores 832 at Va. State Tournament

Carla Galzerano thrilled friends and teammates when she rolled a record-breaking three-game series of 832 at the Virginia State Women's Bowling Association Tournament May 2 at AMF Hanover Lanes in Mechanicsville.

Using a new Black Ice Zone, the 36-year-old left-hander from Woodbridge tossed games of 244-288-300 in Division 1 doubles competition. The series moved her and partner Ryane Bulka into third place during the tournament's second week.

Galzerano, WDCAWBA's ninth-ranked bowler for the 1997-98 season who bowls in three leagues at Bowl America Woodbridge and one league at Bowl America Shirley, entered the event with a 196 average, but she averaged 216 for her nine tournament games. The perfect game was the third of her career, but this was her first 800 series, achieving a goal she had set.
