

Breeden's 1093 Wins Nation's Capital Classic



Elmer Breeden, the top-ranked bowler in the area, topped the 11th annual Nation's Capital Singles Classic held at Fair Lanes University in June.

Breeden had a 5-game total of 1093 in the Classic Division that held up for a \$500 first place. Larry O'Neil was second in the Classic Division with 1085, and Bob Montague was third with 1064.

In the Major Division, Hing Wong chalked up a 5-game score of 1016 for the \$500 first place win. Albert Coleman was second with 992 and Guy T. Napper was third with 983.

Charles Green took the Regular Division first place award of \$200 with a 985. Eric M. King was second with 935 and John T. Watson was third with 892.
