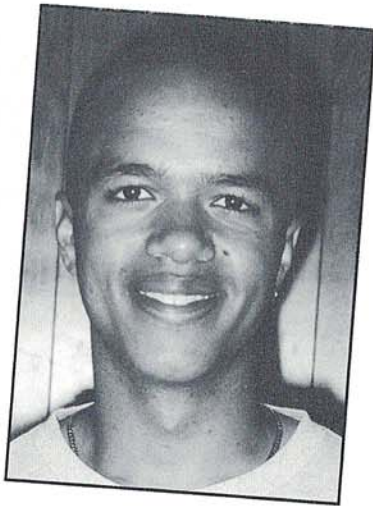


ELVIN DAVISON
