Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- John Cover leads the 30 -year list in games bowled with 104 games more than the second league member on the list (Mike McKittrick)
- Don Freeman now leads the 25-year list for the most games bowled, having bowled seven more games than John and thirteen more games than Mike McKittrick.

The average first game team handicap score was 923.0. The second game (932.6) was the highest scoring game while the third game average (921.2) was eleven pins lower, probably a result of drier lane conditions by the time we reached game three. The following table shows the high handicap team game break out.

#### Abstract

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.


Examining the stats at the end of the year is kind of like examining forensic evidence to find a killer. In fact, you can often find what 'killed' a team's chance to win it all on the season. One of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowls against your team week in and week out. Carry that one step further and look at how well your nearest competitors had teams bowling against them. As a case in point, this year in division $A$, teams \#12 and \#10 had the two highest scratch averages in the league and ended up first and second in the division - with team \#12 edging out team \#10 by one-half point. But team 12's opponents average per game ranked 11th in the division while team \#10's opponents average per game ranked 5th. Could that have accounted for a halfpoint difference over the season? I think so. And the B division story is similar. Team \#17 was the highest averaging team in the division but finished second behind team \#23. Team 17's opponents average per game was the third highest in the division while team \#23's opponents average per game ranked 12th. So once again the stats seem to confirm that, yes, you still have to bowl well to have a chance to win but it also helps if the opposing team isn't always having their best night against you. And, as proof that the other side of that argument also has merit, if you are catching the hot teams every night, you might finish in or near last - just ask teams \# 7 and \#11 who tied for 12th in ' $A$ ' and had the 1st and 2nd highest opponents average per game shot against them in ' $A$ ' this year.

## THE 2008-2009 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2008-2009 season will be remembered as the year the league returned 'home' and for the exceptionally close races in both divisions. Let's review how those races unfolded.

## DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season, the ' $A$ ' division had six different teams that were in first or tied for first. Team \#10, I Inch Snow or Ice, got off to a fast start by going 32-0 in week 1 and was in first or tied for first (week 2 with team \#12, Sherwin-Williams) for the first three weeks. Team \# 6, The Four Horsemen, and team \# 8, Shelton Crew, shared the lead back and forth in weeks 48. Team \#5, BA Gaithersburg, made it's only appearance in first place in week 9. In week 10 team \#4, Myer-Emco, and team \# 6 were tied for first. Team \# 4 had sole possession of first in weeks 11-15 before being displaced by team \# 6 in week 16 and 17. Team \# 4 regained the lead in week 18 and held it for a total of ten more weeks (weeks 18-27), building up as much as a 32 -point lead (in week 23) along the way. But the wheels fell off for team \# 4 the rest of the way as they suffered seven straight losing weeks and ended up fifth in the division. Team \#10 overtook team \# 4 in week 28 on the strength of a six-week winning streak which included back-to-back 30-2 nights. Team \#10 held first place in weeks 28 33 and had the largest lead of any team this year at 36 points after week 32. However, that lead evaporated over the next two weeks when they went 20-44 while team \#12, Sherwin-Williams, went a combined 60-4 in weeks 33 and 34 - good enough to give team \#12 the ' $A^{\prime}$ ' title by one-half point over team \#10. As recounted on page 13, team \#12 then went on to win the league championship match in week 35.

## DIVIVION 'B' RACE

The 'B' division had eight different teams in first during the year. Team \#17 started the year at 31-1 in week 1 and was a factor all year. After team \#17 held first place for the first three weeks, team \#24, Duvall Bonding, took their turn in first for the next three weeks. Team \#16, Silent Paws, took over first place in week 7 but was overtaken by team \#20, Toilet Bowlers, in week 8. Team \#20 held the top spot thru week 11. The next four weeks then saw three different front runners - team \#16 in week 12, team \#27, Carpet Yard, in week 13, and team \#24 in weeks 14 and 15. Team \#27 regained the lead in week 16 but gave it up to team \#16 in week 17. Teams \#16 and \#27 shared first place in week 18 but team \#16 held sole possession of first in weeks 19-21. Team \#21, Over The Hill Gang, made their first appearance in first place in week 22 and held the lead for four consecutive weeks. In fact, team \#21 enjoyed the largest lead all year in the 'B' race - an 18.5-point lead after week 22. Another newcomer to first place took the lead in week 26 and that was team \#23. Team \#17 was in first place for weeks 28 and 29 before being overtaken in week 30 by team \#19, Starmakers - the only week that team \#19 was in first all season. Team \#21 regained the lead in week 31 only to be ousted in week 32 by team \#23, which held onto first the rest of the way. Team \#17 made a good run at the ' $B^{\prime}$ title in week 34 's position round but came up 4.5 points short.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

Another very competitive Commercial League season is in the books.
As has often been pointed out, it will take everyone's cooperation/assistance to add more teams next year. Currently, I have input on three new teams next season - but we have room for lots more. So, how about it - let's all work towards expanding the league. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for the 2009-2010 season.
