Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- John Cover leads the 30-year list in games bowled with 103 games more than the second league member on the list (Don Freeman)
- Mike McKittrick now leads the 25-year list for the most games bowled, having bowled one more game than Don Freeman and three more games than John Cover.
- Scott Williams leads the 20-year list in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, giving him a total of only eight missed nights of bowling the last nineteen seasons. He has had perfect attendance in sixteen of the twenty-three years he has bowled in the Commercial League.
- With yet another season with perfect attendance, Dave Chittum leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5year list with Luis Pinto. Dave has missed one night in the last sixteen years. He and Luis are the only two bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.

To end up as the Commercial League champions, your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. It is common place to see some of the top teams with the lowest opponent's average bowled against them. Similarly, some of the bottom finishing teams seem to have hit the hot teams more than their fair share. As a case in point, this year in division A, team #14 won the division and had the lowest opponents average rolled against them while, on the flip side, the last place team in 'A' (team # 2) had the highest opponent's average shot against them. Likewise, team # 7's second place finish in 'A' was no doubt aided by the fact that their opponent's per game average was ranked 12th in the division - a full 24 pins behind the 938.67 per game average that poor team # 2 faced during the year. Oh, and what did that get team # 2, the team with the second highest scratch average in the division? Nothing but dead last place in 'A'. As another example, look at division 'B'. Teams #15 and #16 finished in 13th and 14th place, respectively, but had the first and second highest opponents average rolled against them during the season. So once again the stats confirm that, yes, you have to bowl well to have a chance to win, but it is also helpful if you are lucky enough to avoid the hot teams each week.

THE 2009-2010 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2009-2010 season will be remembered as the year we experimented with dropping the seven-pin drop rule - an issue sure to be revisited at our organizational meeting in August. It was also another year of exceptionally close races in both divisions. Following is a recap of how those races unfolded.

DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season, the 'A' division had seven different teams that held first place. Team # 4, Toilet Bowlers, got off to a fast start by going 31-1 in week 1, which turned out to be the only week they were in first all year. Team #13, Shelton Crew, was on top of 'A' in weeks 2 thru 4. Team #14, the eventual division winner and league champion, made their first appearance in first place in week 5 and held onto first thru week 7. Team # 1, Mac Attack, made a one-week stop atop the 'A' standings in week 8. Team # 8, Drunk Monkeys, then took over first place for eight consecutive weeks, weeks 9 thru 16. Team 8's reign ended when team # 7, Bowl America Gaithersburg, whipped them badly in consecutive weeks (week 17's regular round and week 18's position round). That also moved team # 7 into the 'A' lead in week 17, a position they held for 16 of the next 17 weeks. John Tragert's team was the dominant team in 'A' for most of the year and at one point held the largest lead over second place - 38.5 points ahead of team # 3 after week 24. In week #29, team # 3 made their only appearance in first place as they held a one-half point lead over team # 7. But team # 7 regained first place in week 30's 'A' versus 'B' position round and held it until team #14 edged them out in week 34's crucial position round. Team #14 had a great run the last third of the season as they booked a 239.5-112.5 record in weeks 24 thru 34. As recounted on page 13, team #14 then went on to win the league championship match in week 35 against team #27, SW Contracting.

DIVIVION 'B' RACE

The 'B' division had six different teams in first during the year. Team #22, The Real Redskins, started the year at 30-2 in week 1, which turned out to be their only week in first place all year. Team #20, Military Might, enjoyed a good early run in 'B' as they held the top spot in weeks 2 thru 12. Team #18, Sherwin-Williams, took over the 'B' lead in week 13 and, with a one-week exception, held onto the lead thru week 25. That lone exception was in week 15 when team #26, Strike Back, held a one-half point lead over team #18. Although team #18 dominated the middle third of the season in 'B', they had a tough last third of the season and eventually ended up in sixth place in their division. Team #25, Controlled Chaos, moved into the 'B' lead for a two-week stay in weeks 26 and 27. Team #26, Strike Back, made their second and last appearance atop 'B' in week 28. In week 29, team #27, SW Contracting, moved into first place in 'B' for the first time and never relinquished the lead after that although their week 34 showdown with team #25 did go down to the final game. Team #25 made a good run at the 'B' title in week 34's position round but came up 6.5 points short after they lost week 34's third team game.

SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

Another very competitive Commercial League season is in the books.

As has often been pointed out, it will take everyone's cooperation/assistance to add more teams next year. As of right now, we have six teams not returning and I have input on one new team and several individual bowlers wanting to join next season. We obviously have room for lots more. So, how about it - let's all work towards expanding the league. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for next season.
