Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Don Freeman overtook John Cover by a mere 5 games to lead the 30-year list in games bowled.
- Mike McKittrick now leads the 25-year list for the most games bowled, having bowled four more game than Don Freeman and twelve more games than John Cover.
- Scott Williams leads the 20-year list in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, giving him a total of only eight missed nights of bowling the last twenty seasons. He has had perfect attendance in seventeen of the twenty-four years he has bowled in the Commercial League.
- With yet another season with perfect attendance, Dave Chittum leads the 15 -year and 10 -year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5 -year list with Luis Pinto. Dave has missed one night in the last seventeen years and has perfect attendance the last eleven years. He, Luis, and Richard Ernst (who missed one game, but was here each week) are the only bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.


## 2010-11 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

Congratulations to team \#16 as they won the league championship in an exciting come-from-behind match with team \# 7, c'Mon Man!!!. After being down 12-4 in points and a total of 43 total pins after the first two games, team \#16 won the third game by 102 pins and the match by an 18-14 margin. The match between the two second place teams also went down to the wire with team \#19, 3:1, using their big 142-pin first game win to prevail against team \# 6, Over The Hill Gang, by a 17.5-14.5 margin. Thanks to each of the top four teams for an entertaining final night and congratulations to each for a fine season!

Individual scoring in the final week was very respectable as the overall league average was 204.1 and there were a total of ten 700s. Gee Lopez finished the season with a pair of $260+$ games and had the high scratch series with a 766. Bruce Lord's 749 was 131 pins over average for star-of-the-week honors. Glenn MacCullough's 748 was his tenth 700 and Chhoeun To's 746 added to his record for the most 700s in a season as he finished with 24 this year. The other 700s were rolled by John Tragert 743, John Holtzclaw 721, Darryl Roberson 709, Dave Chittum 708, Len Chetti 705 and Jay Barrett 704. #### Abstract

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.


To end up as the Commercial League champions, your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. It is common place to see some of the top teams with the lowest opponent's average bowled against them. Similarly, some of the bottom finishing teams seem to have hit the hot teams more than their fair share. As a case in point, this year in division A, team \# 7, C'mon Man!!!, won the division while having the lowest opponents average rolled against them. On the flip side, the last place team in ' $A$ ' (team \# 5, Sherwin-Williams), although leading the league in average, also had the second highest opponent's average shot against them - I guess everyone was getting up to bowl against Chhoeun's big 240 average. Likewise, team \# 8's tenth place finish in ' $A$ ' was no doubt aided by the fact that their opponent's per game average was the highest in the division - a full 30 pins more than division winners faced during the year ( 962.52 vs 932.93 ). For more examples, look at division 'B'. Team \#16's division win was no doubt assisted by the fact that their opponent's score was only 10th best in the division. And then there is team \#20, Sam's Club. Their tenth place finish was due in part to the fact that their opponents, on average, posted the second highest scores against them within the division. So once again the stats confirm that, yes, you have to bowl well to have a chance to win, but it is also helpful if you are fortunate enough to avoid the hot teams week in and week out.

# FALLS CHURCH COMMERCIAL LEAGUE <br> BOWL AMERICA FALLS CHURCH 

THE 2010-2011 SEASON IN REVIEW
The 2010-2011 season will be remembered as the year Chhoeun to broke every high scoring Commercial League record, setting new marks for high average (240.3), 35 weeks without a series under 600 (a streak that is now at 77-in-a-row over the last three seasons), 99 games of 200 or more and four series over 800 (the only 800s in the league this year). It was also memorable for team \# 7's run away win in ' $A$ ' and, at the other end of the spectrum, the down to the wire finish among the top five teams in ' $B$ '. Following is a recap of how those races unfolded.

## DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season, the ' $A$ ' division had six different teams that held first place. Team \#10, Starmakers, held first for the first two weeks before being replaced in week \# 3 by team \#11, Drunk Monkeys. Team \# 6, Over The Hill Gang, took over the top spot for weeks 4 and 5 only to be replaced by team \# 2, Aegis Technologies, in week 6. Team \#12, The Investors, spent their only week in first in week \# 7. Week 8 saw team \#10 regain the lead only to lose it to team \# 2 for weeks 9 and 10. But team \#10 took the lead back in weeks 11 and 12. Week 13 saw a new first place take ' $A$ ' over - and take over they did as team \# 7, C'mon Man!!!, held the 'A' lead for the remaining twenty-two weeks. Team \# 7's most impressive streak during that span was the $194-62$ record they compiled in weeks 23 through 30, an eight-week stretch that all but locked up the division title. In fact, the 64 -point lead team \# 7 held over team \# 6 after week 30 was the largest margin any first-place team held this season. Although team \# 7 dominated the league with a 680-408 won/lost record through week 34, they finished second in the overall league as they were defeated by team \#16 in the league championship match in week 35 (recounted on page 13).

## DIVISION 'B' RACE

Like their ' $A^{\prime}$ counterparts, the ' $B^{\prime}$ division also had six different teams in first during the year. Team \#21 started the year at 29.5-2.5 in week 1, which turned out to be their only week in first place all year. Team \#23, Toilet Bowlers, took over first place in week 2 and enjoyed a good early run in 'B' as they held the top spot for the next twenty weeks and building up leads as large as 39.5 points (after week 18). However, all good things must end and team 23's good thing ended in week 22 when team \#14, Duvall Bail Bonds, moved into the ' $B$ ' lead. Team \#20, Sam's Club, made their one and only appearance in first in week \#23 before team \#14 regained the top spot in week 24. Team \#18, Controlled Chaos, took over the ' $B$ ' lead in week 25 and held that lead through week 31, although they could never pull away from the rest of the pack during that seven-week stretch. Team \#16 took over the ' $B$ ' lead for the first time in week 32 only to lose it back to team \#18 after week 33. However, it turns out that team \#16 was saving their best for last as they won both the week 34 crucial position round against team \#18 and the week 35 league championship match against team \# 7 (recapped on page 13). The ' $B$ ' race provided one of the most exciting finishes we've had as five teams had a chance to win the division going into week 34 's position round.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

As has often been pointed out, it will take everyone's cooperation/assistance to add more teams next year. As of right now, we have three teams not returning and I have input on one new team and several individual bowlers wanting to join next season. We obviously have room for lots more. So, how about it - let's all work towards expanding the league. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for next season.
