Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Don Freeman leads the 30-year list in games bowled having bowled eleven more games than runner-up Mike McKittrick over that time frame.
- Scott Williams leads the 25-year and 20-year lists in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, giving him a total of only seven missed nights of bowling the last twenty seasons and twelve missed nights in the last twenty-five years. He has had perfect attendance in nineteen of the twenty-six years he has bowled in the Commercial League.
- Dave Chittum had another season with perfect attendance and leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5-year list with four other bowlers. Dave has missed only one night in the nineteen years he has bowled in the Commercial League (he started in the 1994-95 season) and has perfect attendance the last thirteen seasons. Dave, Luis Pinto, Richard Ernst, Scott Williams and Bob Haffner are the five bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.

### 2012-13 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

A total of twenty bowlers maintained a perfect attendance record during the year, nine from 'A' and eleven from 'B'. Participation in pre-bowled and post-bowled matches counts towards perfect attendance.

### HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

Despite the fact that teams were bowling vacant teams a lot more frequently this season, there still was only one perfect 32-0 team record on the season. Team #11, VAJJ, did it in week 3 versus the vacant team. That is only the fifth time that a team has gone 32-0 in the eleven seasons we've been using the 32-point format. There were seven times this year when teams got close by going 31-1, with five of those being accomplished versus a vacant team. The two times it was done while bowling an opponent was in week 21 by team #17 against team #16, Over The hill Gang, and in week 33 when team #12, Drunk Monkeys, beat up on team #15, Wild Turkets 2.0.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 65 times in the 344 matches that took place. Team # 6, Myer Connex, led 'A' in doing so as it won 28 or more points on six different occasions. Team #12, Drunk Monkeys, in 'B' led the league in winning 28 or more points on seven different nights. At the opposite extreme, team #11, VAJJ, failed to win at least four points on three different nights, earning the dubious distinction of leading the league in that category.

### SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

To end up as the Commercial League champions, your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. It is common place to see some of the top teams with the lowest opponent's average bowled against them. Similarly, some of the bottom finishing teams seem to have hit the hot teams more than their fair share.

This year's division 'A' winners (and repeating league champions), team # 5, Bowling For Soop, once again provides an excellent example of the above points. Even with the use of a six-man roster, team # 5 had the highest team scratch average in the league at 868.28 while at the same time having the league's lowest opponent's team handicap average bowled against them (922.54). To further illustrate these points, look at the numbers for the division 'B' winners, team #13, Lucky 13. Although team #13 only had the fifth highest team handicap average in their division, they did capitalize on the fact that, collectively, their opponents did not bowl well against them, having the lowest opponent's team handicap average bowled against them in the division.

One other factor came to light as I looked at the chart below. Based on the numbers, I thought that team #17 in 'B' should have fared better in their division. Team #17 had the highest team game scratch average in the division, the third highest team game handicap average, and their opponent's team game handicap average was next to the lowest in division 'B'. But as I looked a little further behind the numbers, team #17 had two bad three-week stretches in the final fourteen weeks that really cost them. The two teams that finished ahead of them in 'B' (teams #13 and #18) bowled much more consistently down the stretch, avoiding those losing streaks that can come back to haunt you.

So once again the stats confirm that, yes, you have to bowl well to have a chance to win, and it is helpful if you are fortunate enough to avoid the hot teams week in and week out. And it is also a good thing to avoid losing streaks, especially coming down the stretch - right team #17?

#### THE 2012-2013 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2012-2013 season will be remembered for divisional races that weren't decided until the week 34 position round and also for the career year that Mike Manolis had. Mike's 237.2 average was the second highest average ever posted in the Commercial League, his five perfect games established a league record, and his three series over 800 just missed tying Chhoeun To's league record of four in that category.

Following is a recap of how this season's divisional races unfolded.

#### DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season the 'A' division had five different teams that held first place. Team # 9, Bethesda Navy, started off in first place only to see team # 8, Tucking Fenpins, take the lead in week 2. Team # 1, Pull My Finger, had their only stay in first after week three but gave up the lead to team # 8 in week 4. Team # 8 held the lead (to include a tie with team # 2 in week 14) all the way through week 16. Team # 9 took over the top spot in weeks 17 and 18 only to have team # 8 regain the lead in weeks 19 and 20. Team # 9 took over the top spot in 'A' one last time in week 21. Team # 2, SW Contracting, moved into first place in week 22 and held it for a total of five weeks. The last lead change in 'A' occurred in week 27 when team # 5, Bowling For Soop, moved into first place for good. Team # 2 did have one last shot at winning the 'A' title in their week 34 divisional position round against team # 5, but team # 5 won that match handily 28-4. Team # 5 went on repeat as league champions by winning their week 35 match with team #13, Lucky 13.

#### DIVISION 'B' RACE

The 'B' division also had five different teams in first place during the year. Team #16, Over The Hill Gang, started the year off at the top after week one, the only time it was in first place all year. Team #11, VAJJ, showed some good early promise in 'B' as they held first place from weeks two through seven. But team #17 took over first place in 'B' after week 8's position round and dominated the division ALMOST the rest of the way, holding onto first place the next twenty-five weeks. Team #17 held the season's largest division lead at 45 points after week 21. But two bad three-way stretches caught up with team #17 and team #18 took over the division lead for the first time after week 33. And then in week 34's critical position round, team #13, Lucky 13, moved into first place for their first and only time when they won the division title by defeating team #18 24-8, ending up with a three-point advantage in total points won. Teams #18 and #17 ended up tied for second place in 'B' after week 34 so a one-game roll off was necessary. Team #18 prevailed in the roll off by 21 pins to secure second place in 'B'.
