Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Don Freeman still leads the 30-year list in games bowled but his lead over runner-up Mike McKittrick over that time frame is down to five games.
- Scott Williams leads the 25-year and 20-year lists in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance once again this year, giving him a total of only six missed nights of bowling the last twenty seasons and eleven missed nights in the last twenty-seven years. He has had perfect attendance in twenty of the twenty-seven years he has bowled in the Commercial League, including perfect attendance the last six years.
- Luis Pinto had another season with perfect attendance and leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5-year list with Scott Williams. Luis has missed only two nights in the fifteen years he has bowled full-time in the Commercial League starting in the 1999-2000 season and has perfect attendance the last eleven seasons. Luis and Scott Williams are the only two bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.

2013-14 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

A total of seventeen bowlers maintained a perfect attendance record during the year, twelve from 'A' and five from 'B'. Participation in pre-bowled and post-bowled matches counts towards perfect attendance.

HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

Despite the fact that an 'A' team was bowling the vacant team each week this season, there still was only one perfect 32-0 team record on the season. Team # 7 did it in week 9 versus the vacant team. That is only the sixth time that a team has gone 32-0 in the twelve seasons we've been using the 32-point format. There were four times this year when teams got close by going 31-1, with three of those being accomplished versus the vacant team. The only time it was done while bowling an opponent was in week 26 by team #12, Myer Connex, when they went 31-1 against team #17, A/R Funding.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 54 times in the 315 matches that took place. Team # 9, Starmakers, led 'A' and the league in doing so as it won 28 or more points on six different occasions (only one of those versus the vacant team). The eventual league champions, team #14, Gutter Hoppers, led 'B' in that category as they won 28 or more on five different nights. At the opposite extreme, team # 4, Bowling For Soop, failed to win at least four points on four different occasions, earning the dubious distinction of leading the league in that category. Team #18, Better Lucky Than Good, got fewer than four points in three different weeks to lead 'B' teams in that category.

INDIVIDUAL AVERAGE CHART

The following chart breaks out individual averages for the league as a whole. Only bowlers (including subs) who rolled at least twenty-one games are included. Of the 81 bowlers with 21 or more games, 50 of them (or 61.7%) averaged 190 or better. However, this season less than half the league (43.2% - 35 out of 81) averaged 200 or better.

SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

This season's Commercial League champions, team #14, Gutter Hoppers, did not fit the typical profile of our league champions. They had the lowest team scratch average in their division and had the highest opponent's average bowled against them. Typically, our league champs (such as Bowling For Soop the last two years) is one of the higher averaging teams and is fortunate enough to have one of the lower opponent's average against them. In fact, this season none of the top four overall teams were one of the top per game scratch averaging teams in their divisions. But they were first and second in their respective divisions for the high per game handicap average.

This year's division 'A' winners, team # 5, SW Contracting, also fared well considering their relatively low team average and how well their opponents bowled against them (fourth highest opponent's average in 'A'). What helped both division winners were winning streaks (see page 13) that propelled them to big leads in their divisions. In 'A', team # 5 had a nine-week stretch in weeks 13-21 where they posted a 226-62 won/lost record. In 'B', team #14 had two winning streaks (weeks 1-4 and weeks 8-19) that left all their competitors in the dust.

One other factor caught my attention as I looked at the chart below. Based on the numbers, team # 4, Bowling For Soop, our two-time defending champions, should have fared better than a fifth place tie. They had the highest team scratch average in the league and had the lowest opponents per game average bowled against them in their division. But, despite their good start, and as pointed out on the previous page, team # 4's poor overall record in 'A' versus 'B' matches (44-148) cost them any opportunity they may have had to three-peat as league champs.

So, in summary, this season having one of the best team handicap game averages was important and putting together big winning steaks were keys to finishing at the top of the divisions. Avoiding losing streaks was also important. None of the top four teams had a losing streak of four weeks or more.

THE 2013-2014 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2013-2014 season will be remembered for runaway, one-team divisional races that resulted in the administration of the lockout rule for both divisions in the week 34 position round - the first time that has happened in Commercial League history. It's also the first time that none of the top four teams are among the higher scratch averaging teams. And that has nothing to do with any changes that were made to the league's handicap percentage - the league has been at 100% handicap since the 2002-2003 season. It just happened that way.

Following is a recap of how this season's divisional races unfolded.

DIVISION 'A' RACE

During the course of the season the 'A' division only had three different teams that held first place. Team # 4, Bowling For Soop, started off the season in serious pursuit of it's third straight league championship. They held first place for the first eight weeks before team # 1, Tucking Fenpins, overtook them in week 9. Team # 1 was in first place for only two weeks before team # 4 regained the top spot in week 11. Team # 4 stayed in first through week #13 before being surpassed in week 14 by the only other, and final, team to lead division 'A' this season - team # 5, SW Contracting. Team # 5 led the rest of the way and was never seriously challenged. Their largest division lead was 86.5 points after week 23. Team # 5 ended up losing the league championship in week 35 but had a great year with their overall second-place finish.

DIVISION 'B' RACE

The 'B' division race had a grand total of two teams that held first place during the year - and one of those was in first place for a grand total of one week. Team #14, Gutter Hoppers, started the year off at the top with a 25-7 record in week one, a mere precursor of what was to come. Team #17. A/R Funding, moved into the top spot in 'B' for the only time in week two. Team #14 took over first place again in week three and ran the table the rest of the way. In fact, there were eleven weeks during the rest of the season when team #14's lead in 'B' was in triple digits, to include it's largest lead of 138.5 points after week 19. Team #14 closed out their first year in the Commercial League with a convincing win over team # 5 to take home the big money in one of the most dominating season's a team has had in our league.

SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

Please help us recruit individual bowlers and/or teams for next year's league. As of right now, we have two teams not returning and I have input on several individual bowlers wanting to join next season. We obviously have room for lots more. So, how about it - let's all work towards expanding the league. Talk to your siblings, spouses, friends, coworkers, bowling buddies, etc. about joining the Commercial League for next season.

Best of luck to Roger Tarr as he relocates to North Carolina to live with his son. RT will be missed as he has been bowling and hanging out at BAFC since it opened in 1960. Anyone willing to do the survival boards, brackets, and high game pots next year?
