Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Mike McKittrick overtook Don Freeman for the most games bowled on the 30-year list. Mike has now bowled thirteen more games than Don over that time frame. John Cover is another eleven games behind Don.
- Once again Scott Williams leads the 25-year and 20-year lists in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, as he has had in twenty-one of the twenty-eight years he has bowled in the Commercial League, including perfect attendance the last seven years.
- Luis Pinto had another season with perfect attendance and leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled and shares the lead on the 5-year list with Scott Williams. Luis has missed only two nights in the sixteen years he has bowled full-time in the Commercial League starting in the 1999-2000 season and has perfect attendance the last twelve seasons. Luis and Scott Williams are the only two bowlers with perfect attendance the last five years.
- Here's a surprising observation (not really). Mike Manolis appears in each of the six tables and holds the highest average for each time period listed.

#### 2014-15 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

Nineteen bowlers maintained a perfect attendance record during the year. Participation in pre-bowled and post-bowled matches counts towards perfect attendance, as does a night when a bowler bowls only one or two games.

#### HIGHLIGHTS FROM WEEK #35 - 6 MAY 2015

Once again, congratulations to team #12, Surly Turkeys, for winning both halves and, as a result, the overall league championship. Team # 1, Tucking Fenpins, ended up as the league runnerup after winning 21 points in the final week's position round showdown with team #14, Ebowla. Team # 1's 597-523 overall cumulative record secured their second-place overall finish.

Scores were down slightly in the final week with the league average coming in at 195.8. There were four 700s. Mike Clark had the highest scratch series with a 739 and the high scratch game with a 'front nine' 279 in his third game. That gave Mike star-of-the-week honors at 148 pins over his average. Barry Haddox was already locked into first place in the individual points won category and ended up with 89 points won. Mike McKittrick finished second in that category with 82.5 points, Tom Horton third with 79 points and Seth Ballentine fourth with 78 points.

As already mentioned, team # 1, Tucking Fenpins, defeated team #14, Ebowla, in the week 35 match with the most money at stake. Team # 9, A/R Funding, bowled well enough in their match against team # 5, SW Contracting, to win 21 points and finish with the third best cumulative record at 594.5-525.5. For the second straight week, team #10, Myer Connex, had the high team handicap series, this time with a 2946 total (Steve Sipe 702, Glenn MacCullough 693, Willie Williams 644 and John Austin 610).

#### FOUR-IN-A-ROW 600+ CLUB

Andrew Blackmore (701) finished the year with a string of thirty-two-in-a-row. The only series under 600 for Andrew this year was a 510 in week 3, a night when the shot was particularly ugly (the lowest averaging night for the season at 167.3). Allen Walker (600) finished with just enough to end up with twenty-two-in-a-row. Mike Manolis (652) made it to double digits with ten-in-a-row. Josh Hurdle (731) had his last eight-in-a-row. Willie Williams (644) moved up to six-in-a-row in the final night and Dan Test (636) finished the season with five-in-a-row. Week 35 had five new club members making it to four-in-a-row - Steve Sipe 702, Luis Pinto 697, Noel Dysart 634, Scott Williams 625 and Bryan Anderson 618. The final week also had five club dropouts - Van Koppersmith after 11-in-a-row, Seth Ballentine after 9-in-a-row, Carl Armstrong and Sam Highsmith after 6-in-a-row, and Gabe Kiblin after 5-in-a-row.

#### HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

There was only one perfect 32-0 team record on the season. Team # 5, SW Contracting, did it in week 19 versus team # 8. That makes seven times that a team has gone 32-0 in the thirteen seasons we've been using the 32-point format. There were two other times this year when teams got close by going 31-1. Team #11, Gutter Hoppers, won 31 against team # 8 in week 5 and team #12, Surly Turkeys, thrashed team #10, Myer Connex, 31-1 in week 13.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 45 times in the 245 matches that took place. Our league champions, team #12, Surly Turkeys, led the league in doing so as it won 28 or more points on eight different occasions. That no doubt was a huge contributing factor in their winning both halves. Team # 5, SW Contracting, was next in that category as they won 28 or more points on five different nights. At the opposite extreme, team # 8 and team #10, Myer Connex, failed to win at least four points on four different occasions, earning the dubious distinction of tying for the league lead in that category. Three other teams (team # 2, Over The Hill Gang, team # 4, GordO Face, and #12, Surley Turkeys) got fewer than four points in three different weeks for runner-up honors in that category.

#### SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

This season's Commercial League champions, team #12, Surly Turkeys, fit the typical profile of most of our past league champions. They had the third highest handicap game average and was fortunate to catch teams on other than their best nights as their opponent's handicap game average was next to the lowest of all the teams in the league (as you expected, Tom). The Surly Turkeys got off to a terrible start, sitting in last place after week 7 with a 77.5-146.5 record. But then they got hot for an extended period (another common trait of past league champions), going 250.5 and 69.5 the rest of the first half.

One of the most telling stats in determining where a team finishes is how well the opponents have bowled against a team over the course of the whole season. In addition to team #12 this year, another good example is team # 2, Over The Hill Gang. Even though they had the highest handicap game average they also had their opponents bowling well against them week in and week out, with their opponents having the second highest opponent's handicap game average. As a result, team # 2 finished ninth in each half and ninth overall. (Or, maybe their opponents were throwing more strikes in an effort to speed up the match. More often than not the Over The Hill Gang was the last to turn in a recap.)

I think one other factor that impacted a lot of teams this year, more than in seasons past, was the ten-pin drop rule. With the 'challenging' lane conditions over the first several weeks, a lot of us were significantly under our entering average when the ten-pin rule kicked in after week 3. At that point, 74 percent of the bowlers with nine games bowled were more than ten pins under their entering averages. The resulting penalty in lost handicap was undoubtedly a game-changer in a lot of the first-half matches. Team # 4, GordO Face, and team #10, Myer Connex, seemed to be hit the hardest as even by the end of the first half (week 17) they each were still losing close to 20 pins of handicap a game because of the ten-pin drop rule.

So, in summary, Team #12's winning formula this season was having one of the best team handicap game averages, catching opponents on their 'off nights', and putting together a decent winning streak the last ten weeks of the first half. They also did a good job of overcoming the handicap pins lost because of the ten-pin drop rule penalty that was adversely impacting a lot of other teams.

#### THE 2014-2015 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2014-2015 season will be remembered for a change from a two-division format to a single division format with a split season schedule. The format change was implemented because the total number of teams dropped to fourteen. Team #12, Surly Turkeys, ended up winning both halves, a difficult thing to do in a split season format.

Following is a recap of how this season's races unfolded for each half.

#### FIRST-HALF RACE

Last year's champions, team #11, Gutter Hoppers, picked up where they left off last year, winning 30 points on opening night and grabbing the top spot after week 1. Team # 7 moved into first place after week two but relinquished the lead back to team #11 in week 3. Team #11 ran off a nice winning streak the first eight weeks, compiling a 200.5-55.5 record, and holding a 52-point lead over team # 1, Tucking Fenpins, at that point. Due to the large lead they had built up, team #11 continued to hold first place through week 11, although their lead over second place was shrinking each week. Team #14, Ebowla, finally overtook team #11 for first place in week 12 and held onto first place in week 13. Team #11 regained first place in week 14 and clung to a 2.5-point lead over a red-hot team #12, Surly Turkeys, after week 15. Thanks to a great stretch run in weeks 15-17 (winning 29.5 points, 29 points and 22 points, respectively), the Surly Turkeys ended up winning the first half by 10.5 points over team # 1, Tucking Fenpins. Not bad considering team #12 was in dead last place after week 7.

#### SECOND-HALF RACE

The second-half race saw three different teams sharing the lead over the seventeen weeks it covered. It started out as a real sea saw affair with lead changes in each of the first five weeks. Team #12 led after week one, team #14 after week two, team #10 after week three, back to team #14 after week four and then team #10 took the lead in week five. Team #10 then held onto first place for the next five weeks, having their biggest lead of 20 points after week nine. Team #12 finally caught and passed team #10 in week eleven of the second half and held the lead the rest of the way. Since team #12's lead was more than 32 points going into the second-half final position round, the lockout rule was applied and the second and third place teams (team #10 and team #14) got to go head-to-head to see who would finish second. Team #10 won that critical match by a 24.5-7.5 margin and finished second in the second-half standings. That was a nice turn around for team #10 who had finished dead last in the first half.
