Some observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Don Freeman has the most games bowled on the 30-year list, nine more than teammate Scott Williams. Willie Williams is third on the 30 year list, a distant 278 games behind Scott.
- Once again Scott Williams leads the 25-year and 20-year lists in games bowled. Scott had perfect attendance again this year, as he has had in twenty-two of the twenty-nine years he has bowled in the Commercial League, including perfect attendance the last eight years.
- Luis Pinto missed one week this season but still leads the 15-year and 10-year lists in games bowled. Luis has missed only three nights in the seventeen years he has bowled full-time in the Commercial League starting in the 1999-2000 season, with perfect attendance in fourteen of those seasons.
- Scott Williams and David Kunkel are the only two league members with perfect attendance the past five seasons.
- Mike Manolis appears in each of the six tables and holds the highest average for every time period except on the 20 year list, on which he has the second highest average. Carl Armstrong edges Mike out for high average on the 20 list (213.66 to 213.23).
- Sixteen league members have enough longevity over an extended period to show up on all six tables Andy Anderson, Bryan Anderson, Kevin Anderson, Mike Clark, Noel Dysart, Richard Ernst, Don Freeman, Gabe Kiblin, Mike Leach, Ted Lutz, Mike Manolis, Scott Miller, Luis Pinto, Scott Williams, Willie Williams and Scott Wilson.

HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

There were no clean sweep (32-0) matches on the season, a feat accomplished only six times in the thirteen seasons we've been using the 32-point format. Team #13, Bowling For Soop, came the closest to doing it this season in week 2 when they went 31.5-.5 against team #15, Inglorious Turkeys. On three other occasions teams got close by going 31-1. Team #15 had another close call at being swept in week 33 when team #14, Bethesda Navy, won 31 points from them. Team #15 was on the winning ended of a one-sided match in week 6 when they went 31-1 versus team # 9, Gamecock. The other 31-1 match this year was in week 8 when team #7, SW Contracting, beat up on team # 4, A/R Funding.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 41 times in the 288 matches that took place. Three teams did it five times each to lead the league in doing so - team # 3, Over The hill Gang; team # 4, A/R Funding, and team #15, Inglorious Turkeys. Two of those same teams (teams # 4 and #15) were on the opposite end of the won/lost spectrum, failing to win at least four points on four different occasions, to lead the league in that category.

The two division champs this year used the same formula for their success. They won 20 or more points the most times in their division (team # 7 did it 18 times in 'A' and team #11 did it 22 times in 'B') and they each won fewer than 8 points only once all year.

SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

To win the Commercial League, your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. It is common place to see some of the top teams with the lowest opponent's average bowled against them. Similarly, some of the bottom-finishing teams seem to have hit the hot teams more than their fair share.

This season's division winners bowled well enough to have the highest (team # 7 in 'A') and second highest (team #11 in 'B') handicap game average in their respective divisions. And they were both fortunate enough to catch teams on less than their best nights as their opponents' average was ranked 7th and 6th within their divisions. On the other hand, the two teams that finished last in each division (team # 1, Messing With Sasquatch, in 'A' and team # 9, Gamecock, in 'B'), had the highest opponent's team average bowled against them. That makes it a long season for sure.

Of course other factors in addition to the scratch, handicap and opponents' average per game come into play during the nine-month long season. Winning streaks are important and both division winners had those during the year. In fact, team 11's nine-week winning streak between January 13th and March 16th where they went 211-77 put them over the top in 'B'. The other notable factor was how well the two division winners bowled against their nearest rivals. In 'A', team # 7, SW Contracting, had a 109-51 record against runner up team # 6, Queen & 3 Jokers, in the five times they met. Likewise, in 'B' the two top teams met seven times and the eventual division winner (team #11) won 144 points while losing only 80 against the division 'B' runner up (team #10).

One other factor came to light as I looked at the chart below. Based on the numbers, I thought that team #13, Bowling For Soop, in 'B' should have fared better in their division. Team #13 had the second highest team game scratch average in the league and their opponent's team game handicap average was next to the lowest in division 'B'. But as I looked a little further behind the numbers, team #13 had a seven-week losing streak in weeks 15-21 that buried them in last place. Although they had a great run the last third of the season, going from last place after week 24 to third place after week 35, that 60-164 losing streak starting in week 15 proved to be too much to overcome.

THE 2015-2016 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2015-2016 season saw a change back to our league's traditional two-division format after one season with a single division format with a split season schedule. Following is a recap of how this season's divisional races unfolded.

DIVISION 'A' RACE

The 'A' division had five different teams in first place during the course of the season. Team # 4, A/R Funding, was in first after week 1, the only time they held the top spot all year. Team # 6, Queen & 3 Jokers, was in first after week 2 but was replaced in weeks 3 and 4 by team # 2, Watch Outheway. Team # 6 regained first place in week 5 and held it through week 9. In week 10 team # 8, Myer Connex, took over the 'A' lead and kept it through week 14. In week 15's divisional position round, team # 7, SW Contracting, defeated team # 8 27-5 to take over first place. A week later team # 6 moved into first place for the third time and held it from weeks 16 through week 23. Weeks 24 and 25 decided the outcome of the 'A' race when team # 7 defeated team # 6 in consecutive weeks by a 49-15 margin. Team # 7 virtually coasted the rest of the way in first place, building a lead over second place that reached as high as 81 points after week 33. Team # 7 lost the week 36 championship match to team #11 to finish second overall for the season. Team # 6 finished second in the division and third overall thanks to a strong showing in weeks 35 and 36.

DIVISION 'B'

There were only four teams that held first place in 'B' during the year. Team #14, Bethesda Navy, started the year off in first place for the first two weeks. Team #13, Bowling For Soop, made its first move into the 'B' lead in week 3 only to see team #14 move back into the top spot in weeks 4 and 5. Team #13 took the lead again in week 6 but never saw first place again. Team #16, Gutter Hoppers, was in first for their only time in week 7. The rest of the way in 'B' it was all about team #11 as they took over the lead in week 8 and never relinquished it. Just as was the case in 'A', weeks 24 and 25 essentially ended the 'B' race as team #11 dominated the second place team #10 in consecutive weeks, winning 47 points while losing only 17. The largest lead that team #11 enjoyed was 83.5 points after week 33. They went on to win the championship match in week 36. Team #10 did manage to finish second in the division and in fourth place overall.

SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

Please help us recruit individual bowlers and/or teams for next year's league. We will keep our 7 p.m. starting time which should help us attract both some of our old league members as well as some new bowlers.
