- Teammates Scott Williams (3117 games) and Don Freeman (3000 games) have the most games bowled on the 30 -year list. Mike McKittrick is third on the 30 year list with 2722 games, 278 games behind Don.
- Scott Williams leads each of the lists in the number of games bowled. Once again Scott had perfect attendance this year which gives him perfect attendance in twenty-five of the thirty-two years he has bowled in the Commercial League, including perfect attendance the last eleven years.
- John Holtzclaw and Pat Dishner are tied with Scott Williams for the most games bowled the past five seasons as they have each had perfect attendance over that time span.

RECORD SETTING NIGHTS FOR 2018-2019
The overall average for the season was 195.5 , just slightly higher than last season's average of 195.3. A brief summary of this season's best nights follows.


## HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

There were no clean sweep (32-0) matches this season, a feat accomplished only 12 times in the previous fifteen seasons that we've been using the 32 -point format. Two teams came close with 31-1 records (team \# 5 versus team \# 4 in week 22 and team 15 versus team \# 1 in week 26).

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 49 times in the 360 matches that took place. Two teams did five times on the year - team \# 5 in ' $A$ ' and team \#18, Over The Line, in ' $B$ '. On the other hand, two teams never won 28 or more even once - team \# 6, Revenge of the Turkeys, in ' $A$ ' and team \#16, Bethesda Navy in ' $B$ '.

It comes as no surprise that the two division winners (team \# 4, A/R Funding, in ' $A$ ' and team \#19, Blind Squirrels, in ' $B^{\prime}$ ') won 20 or more points the most times in the league. Team \#19 did it 21 times on their way to the league's best record at $706.5-445.5$. Team \# 4 won 20 or more points on 19 different nights. And those two teams were also the best at avoiding the big losing nights. Each of them won less than 8 points only twice all season. And the two division runners up were the next most successful at avoiding big losses. Team \# 2 and team \#18 won less than eight points only three times all season.

## SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TEAM GAME AVERAGES RANK ORDERED

Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

To be the Commercial League champion your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. That held true again this season in that the two division winners (team \# 4, A/R Funding, and team \#19, Blind Squirrels) had two of the lower opponent's average bowled against them all season. Some of the lower finishing teams have the opposite experience, i.e. they seem to have the opposition bowling above average against them every week. Both last place teams this season (team \# 1 and team \#16, Bethesda Navy) had the highest opponent's average bowled against them in their respective divisions.

Of course other factors in addition to the scratch, handicap and opponents' average per game come into play during the nine-month long season. To win the division title you have to win your matches against the other teams within your division. It comes as no surprise that the top two teams in each division this season had the best winning percentages in their regularly scheduled division matches. Winning streaks and avoiding big losing nights are also important. Both division winners had seven-week winning streaks and neither had a losing streak of four or more weeks. And both teams \# 4 and \#19 won less than eight points only twice all year - the only two teams to do that.

Another factor in winning the division title sometimes depends on how well the first place team fared against the eventual runner up in their division. This season both division winners had winning records against the runner-up teams. In ' $A$ ', team \# 4 held a 53-43 advantage in their three matches with team \# 2. In ' $\mathrm{B}^{\prime}$, team \#19 defeated team \#18 by a 41-23 margin the two times they met.

THE 2018-2019 SEASON IN REVIEW
The 2018-2019 season featured divisional races that were pretty much over by the last third of the schedule. There were some interesting parallels between the two division winners. Team \# 4, A/R Funding, and team \#19, Blind Squirrels, moved into first place in their divisions for the first time at the season's half-way point, week 18. Both had a 7 -week winning streak in the second half to solidify their holds on first place. With a 64-point division lead, team \#19 didn't even have to bowl the second-place team in the week 35 position round. Team \# 4 wasn't quite that lucky but did prevail thanks in part to their 11.5point lead over team \# 2 going into that week 35 match. Team \# 4 then won the league championship over team \#19 in week 36 . That match is summarized on page 13. Following is a recap of how this season's divisional races unfolded.

## DIVISION 'A' RACE

Seven of the ten teams in 'A' were in first place at some point during the season. Team \# 3, Seis Manos, was in first for its only time after week 1. Team \# 9, Bowling Team Assemble, spent the next three weeks in first place before giving way to team \# 1 for weeks 5 thru 7. Team \# 5 was in first place for weeks 8 thru 15, although they had to share the week 15 lead with team \# 6, Revenge of the Turkeys. Team \# 8, Out of Bubble Gum, took over first place in ' A ' for weeks 16 and 17 before being replaced by team \# 4, A/R Funding. Team \# 8 did retake the ' $A$ ' lead briefly in weeks 22 and 23 , but after that team \# 4 held the lead the rest of the way. Team \# 2 was one of three teams that was never if first in ' $A$ ' but they did finish as the runner-up in ' $A$ ' and third place overall for the year.

## DIVISION 'B'

Division ' $\mathrm{B}^{\prime}$ only had three teams that were in first place during the season. Team \#17 started the year in first and was in the top spot for five different weeks as they flipped back and forth with team \#11 for the first 17 weeks. Team \#19, Blind Squirrels, moved into first place for the first time in week 18. Team \#11 fought their way back into the 'B' lead in weeks 19 and 20 only to see team \#19 take over first place for the rest of the way starting in week 21. Just as was the case in ' $A$ ' this year, team \#18 finished the season in second place in ' $B^{\prime}$ despite never having led the division for a single week. Team \#18 finished in fourth place overall as they lost to team \# 2 in the week 36 position round.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

As always, we could use everyone's help in recruiting individual bowlers and/or teams for next year's league. We will keep our 7 p.m. starting time. All 20 of this season's teams signed up to return next season but we still have room to add teams.
