- Glenn MacCullough's 218.32 average led the 10 -year list but Chris Price took over the top spot on the 5-year list with a 221.06 composite average.

HOT STREAKS and NOT-SO-HOT STREAKS - ONLY HAPPENED ONCE
I define a streak as four or more consecutive weeks of winning (or losing) 20 or more points each week. Since we basically had the same eight teams bowl each league session, I considered the combined thirty-four weeks that each team bowled when looking for winning and losing streaks of four or more weeks - and surprisingly there was only one winning streak that met that criteria. Team \# 7, the eventual second session league champions, started off that session with a four-week winning streak and a 100-28 won/lost record. They added two more three-week winning streaks that pretty much clinched their run for the title. I think our two-session schedule with a total of seven fairly evenly matched teams to bowl against was a key factor in the lack of 'streaks' this season.

## HOW DID THIS YEAR'S LEAGUE AVERAGE COMPARE TO THE LAST TWO YEARS?

The league average this year was 195.6 which is slightly higher than the previous two seasons' composite average. The league average for the first session this season was very low at 191.6. Everyone must have got used to wearing a mask while bowling in the second session as that league composite average almost got to 200. RECORD SETTING NIGHTS FOR 2020-2021


HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT
This season was unique in a lot of ways. The season was divided into two different league sessions, each running 17 weeks. When the second session started up in January, new team numbers were assigned based on the finishing order of the first session. For the most part, team compositions stayed the same. The table below covers each team's performance for the entire season.

There were no clean sweep (32-0) matches this season, a feat accomplished only 12 times in the previous seventeen seasons that we've been using the 32 -point format. And only one match's outcome was $31-1$ this season. In week 5 of the second session ( 24 Feb ) team \#1/2 defeated team \#8/5 by that margin in a match that team \#1/2 won by 362 total pins. Interestingly enough, there was only one other match all season with a 30-2 result when team \#7/3 defeated team \#8/5 in the final night of session II on 19 May.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 14 times in the 136 matches that took place. Team \# 5/1, Erratic, was the only team to do it more than twice and they did it four times. That also helped Erratic to the season's best overall won/lost record at 588.5-499.5 and first and third place finishes, respectively. On the other hand, four of the league's eight teams only won 28 or more points one time all year.

Team \#3/7 won 20 or more points seventeen times, exactly half of the thirtyfour weeks we bowled. And team \#3/7 did it ten of the seventeen weeks in the second league session. No wonder they ended up winning it! Avoiding the big losing nights also helps a team finish higher in the standings. The only team to avoid winning less than four points in any given week was team \#4, Drunk Monkeys. That no doubt helped the Drunk Monkeys to their fourth and second place finishes, respectively.

The following table shows how each team finished each session and the number of times that each team won the number of points indicated in the last eight columns for the entire season.

The results of the second session mirrored that of the first session. THE 'COVID-19' 2020-2021 SEASON IN REVIEW
The 2020-2021 bowling season will be one we will all remember for its uniqueness. Remembered for such things as social distancing, mask wearing, skipping every other pair of lanes, the constant sanitation efforts in the bowling center and for the fact that many of our regular bowlers took part or all of the season off. Since the full impact and timing of the pandemic was very much an unknown in August of 2020, a decision was made at the beginning of the season to break the league into two separate 17 -week sessions. Session I ran from August into December 2020. Session II ran from January into May 2021. Even though we had been hopeful that more teams would be willing to bowl in the second session, both sessions ended up having eight teams. Below is a summary of how the races in each session unfolded.

## SESSION-I RACE

Four of the eight teams held first place for at least one week during session $I$, and they all did that in the first four weeks. Team \#5, Erratic, was atop the standings after week 1, followed by teams \#7, \#1 and \#6 the next three weeks. Starting in week 5 it was a two-horse race as only teams \# 5 and \# 7 were in first place the rest of the way. Team \# 5 had sole possession of first place seven more weeks and enjoyed the largest lead over second place of any team in the first session - a 25 -point lead after week 12. Team \# 7 held the top spot five more times and managed to close the gap on team \# 5 after week 12. In fact, after week 16 those two teams were tied for first place. Week 17's position round match decided the outcome of session I as team \# 5, Erratic, prevailed with a convincing 23 -point win to wrap up first place.

## SESSION-II RACE

Just as in the first session, four of the eight teams were in first place at some point in the second session. Team \# 1, Erratic, and team \# 7 shared first place after week 1. Starting with week two, team \# 7 was pretty much in control the rest of the way, holding first place in 11 of the final 16 weeks. The one major exception to that was a two-week losing streak in weeks 7 and 8 when team \# 7 went a combined 12-52. That allowed team \# 6 to hold first place for three weeks and team \# 1 for one week. The last remaining glitch on an otherwise dominating performance by team \# 7 was a 7-25 loss to team \# 4 in week 12 's position round. That left team \# 7 in second place, 4.5 points behind The Drunk Monkeys. But team \# 7 reasserted itself from week 13 on and ended up finishing 29.5 points ahead of the second-place team, team \# 4.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

As always, but especially true as we work to get more of our bowlers back, we could use everyone's help in recruiting individual bowlers and/or teams for the upcoming 2021-2022 Commercial League season. It would be great to get back to the 20 teams we had before COVID hit. That would also ensure a return to our traditional two-division format. And we still have room to add teams. I will be contacting team captains later this summer to confirm your team's status.

As noted at the bottom of page 16 , once again this year the proceeds from the Reggie Rich Tribute fund were used to support the youth bowling program here at BAFC. A special thanks to Diana Booth for selling 50/50 tickets each week to make that donation possible. Also, another big thank you to John Hendrick for his generous support and the fine example he sets for others. As most of you know, John always donates all of his 50/50 winnings to the Reggie fund. And now others do much the same, resulting in an increase in individual donations. To me, the fact that our little 8 -team league donated $\$ 2,182.50$ to the Reggie Rich Tribute Fund is an incredible way to honor an incredible man. Well done!
