Some observations concerning the above four tables and my supporting data files:

- Scott Williams still has the most games bowled for each of the 30, 25 and 20-year lists. Scott and John Holtzclaw are tied for the most games bowled with 1533 games over the past 15 years. Each of them has only missed five nights of the Commercial League over the past 15 years. Over that 15 year stretch, Scott has 13 years and John has twelve years of perfect attendance.
- Glenn Maccullough has the highest average for league members that qualified for the 30,20 and 15 year 'top 20' lists. Glenn has the second-highest average on the 25 -year list as his 213.16 composite average is just behind Mike Manolis' 213.48 leading average.

Additional observations concerning the preceding tables and my supporting data files:

- Twelve current league members have enough sustained longevity in the league to have appeared on all six lists. In alphabetical order they are - Andy Anderson, Bryan Anderson, Kevin Anderson, Carl Armstrong, Noel Dysart, Richard Ernst, John Holtzclaw, Glenn MacCullough, Hollis McMullen, Scott Miller, Scott Williams and Willie Williams.
- John Holtzclaw and Scott Williams are tied for the most games bowled over the last 10 years ( 1032 out of a possible 1038). Chris Price heads up the 5 -year list and is the only Commercial league member with perfect attendance over the last five years.
- Glenn MacCullough's 218.32 average led the 10 -year list but Chris Price took over the top spot on the 5 -year list with a 226.52 composite average.
- Many of our long-term 'regular' league members sat out the Covid19impacted 2020-2021 season and therefore did not qualify to be recognized in some of the previous tables for their longevity in the Commercial League. We were glad to see their smiling faces back for the 2021-2022 season (e.g. Don Freeman, Mike Manolis, Ted Lutz, Gabe Kiblin, Sam Highsmith, et al.).


## 2021-22 Commercial League Perfect Attendance

Ten bowlers maintained a perfect attendance record during the year, three in ' $A$ ' and seven in ' $B$ '. Pre-bowled and post-bowled matches count towards perfect attendance, as does a night when a bowler bowls only one or two games.

## HOW YOUR TEAM DID IN THE WON/LOST DEPARTMENT

There were two clean sweep (32-0) matches this season, a feat now accomplished only 14 times in the previous eighteen seasons that we've been using the 32point format. Team \# 1, We're Big In Japan, did it against the blind team in week 22 and team \#14, Irritable Bowl Syndrome, did it in week 31, also against the blind. Another five match's outcome were 31-1 this season.

Winning 28 or more points in a match is also no easy task as it was done only 61 times in the 360 matches that took place. Team \#12, Brooklyn Proud 2, accomplished that feat six times, the most by any team. The team that won 28 or more points the fewest times all year (once) was, strangely enough, team \#1 - the night they went 32-0.

Team \#18, Inconceivabowl, the 'B' runner-up, won 20 or more points twentythree times, the most times in the league and a big reason that they posted the best win-loss record in the league at 673-479. The ' $B$ ' champions, team \#19, Erratic, did it the second-most times (eighteen times) on their way to the second-place overall league finish. Team \#19 and team \#16, Stone Age Strikers, were best at avoiding the big losing nights as each of them won less than 8 points only twice all season. The next most successful teams at avoiding big losses were team \#12, Brooklyn Proud 2, and team \#15, A/R Funding, each winning less than eight points only three times all season.

So, this season Sue was provided a payment for her efforts from the Reggie fund.

Sadly, John Hendrick passed away in February this year after a long battle with cancer. John was a huge supporter of the Reggie Rich Tribute Fund since it was established in May 2017. Over the past 3 seasons alone, John donated over $\$ 2,800$ to the Reggie fund out of his own pocket - and that doesn't even take into account additional donations others made following the fine example John set when he donated all his winnings whenever he won $50 / 50$ drawings in his leagues. To honor John's memory, the Reggie fund paid John's remaining league fees owed as a gift to his estate. And, John's Commercial League team, team \# 2, Waffle House Heroes, dobated his $\$ 2,200$ share of first-place money to the Reggie Rich Tribute Fund in memory of John.

Once again, thanks for any and all individual donations as well as the contributions from leagues that donate their $50 / 50$ proceeds to the Reggie fund. Listed below, for each division, are each team's averages for scratch game (column 1) and handicap game (column 2) categories. Column three shows the rank order of the opposing team's average handicap game.

To be the Commercial League champion your team has to both bowl well during the year and be fortunate enough to catch your opponents on other than their best nights. At the conclusion of each season, one of the more telling stats is always how well the opposition bowled against your team. That held true again this season for three of the top 4 overall finishers. Teams \# 2 and \# 7 finished first and second in the division but had the lowest and next-lowest opponent averages against them in ' $A$ '. The same held true for team \#18, the second place team in 'B', who had the 7 th lowest opponents average rolled against them. Some of the lower finishing teams have the opposite experience, i.e. they seem to have the opposition bowling above average against them every week. That was very much the case for team \# 3 in ' $A$ ' who had the 2nd highest opponent's average rolled against them within their division.

Of course other factors in addition to the scratch, handicap and opponents' average per game come into play during the nine-month long season. To win the division title you have to win your matches against the other teams within your division. It comes as no surprise that the top three teams in 'A' and two of the top three teams in ' $B$ ' had the best winning percentages in their regularly scheduled division matches. Winning streaks and avoiding big losing nights are also important. Team \# 2 in ' $A$ ' had a four-week winning streak and no extended losing streak. On the 'B' side, team \#19 had two five-week winning streaks which helped to offset the one four-week losing streak they had. Team \#19 was also aided by the fact that they won less than eight points only twice all year.

Another factor in winning the division title sometimes depends on how well the first place team fared against the eventual runner up in their division. This season both division winners held their own against the runner-up teams. In ' $A$ ', team \# 2 held a 55-41 advantage in their three matches with team \# 7. In 'B', team \#19 and team \#18 were fairly evenly matched, although team \#18 did have a 66-62 advantage in the four times they met.

## THE 2021-2022 SEASON IN REVIEW

After two seasons of dealing with a variety of covid19 issues, the 2021-2022 bowling season was pretty much a return to normalcy. Our league fielded eighteen teams and returned to our traditional two-division format. The following paragraphs summarize highlights of the divisional races.

## DIVISION ' $A$ ' RACE

Five of the nine teams in ' $A$ ' held first place for at least one week during the season, with four of those teams doing so in the first six weeks. Things settled down a bit starting in week 8 as team \# 1, We're Big In Japan, took the lead and held it through week 14. Team \# 7, That's Radical, took over first place in week 15 and stayed there for thirteen consecutive weeks. In week 28, team \# 5, Dead Man Walk'n, took the 'A' lead and held it for four of the next five. Team \# 7 moved back into first place for a one-week stay in week 30, the last time they would be in first. In week 33, team \# 2, Waffle House Heroes, moved into the top spot for the first time since week 7 and ended up winning the division by 21 points over team \# 7. As noted on page 13, team \# 2 went on to win the league championship in week $36^{\prime}$ s match between the division winners.

## DIVISION 'B' RACE

Five of the nine 'B' teams held first place at least for one week during the season. Team \#14, Irritable Bowl Syndrome, and team \#16, Stone Age Strikers, were the early leaders in 'B', as one of those two teams was in first place for twelve of the first thirteen weeks. That all changed in week 14 when team \#19, Erratic, moved into first place and pretty much dominated 'B' the rest of the way. Team \#18, Inconceivabowl, stayed within striking distance, and even took the 'B' lead in weeks 25 thru 28. However, team \#19 weathered that storm, regaining the lead in week 29 and winning by just enough the rest of the way to claim the 'B' title in their week 35 showdown with team \#18.

## SOME LAST MINUTE THOUGHTS

As always, but especially true as we work to get more of our bowlers back, we could use everyone's help in recruiting individual bowlers and/or teams for the upcoming 2022-2023 Commercial League season. It would be great to have at least the 20 teams we had before COVID hit. That would also ensure the continuation of our traditional two-division format. And we still have room to add teams. I will be contacting team captains later this summer to confirm your team's status.

A special thanks to Diana Booth for selling 50/50 tickets each week to make that donation possible. With John Hendrick's passing, we will miss his generous support and the fine example he set for others. I hope others will continue to donate part or all of their 50/50 winnings to the Reggie fund. Altogether, this season the Commercial League donation to the Reggie Rich Tribute Fund totaled \$4,724.40an incredible way to honor both Reggie and John's memories. Well done!
