

Smith and Parks capture Maryland Masters Doubles

Norman Smith and Satch Parks rolled a 1,533 handicap total (1,421 + 112) to win the \$3,000 top prize in the 4th annual Maryland Masters Doubles Tournament, which took place Sept. 22 through Nov. 25 at Bowl America Kent. The duo won an extra \$200 for having the high set handicap on Thanksgiving weekend. Linda Tragert and Bret Lewis earned \$1,600 for their 1,505 runner-up score. Eddie Lowe and Willie Coleman were third with 1,470 and they pocketed \$800.
