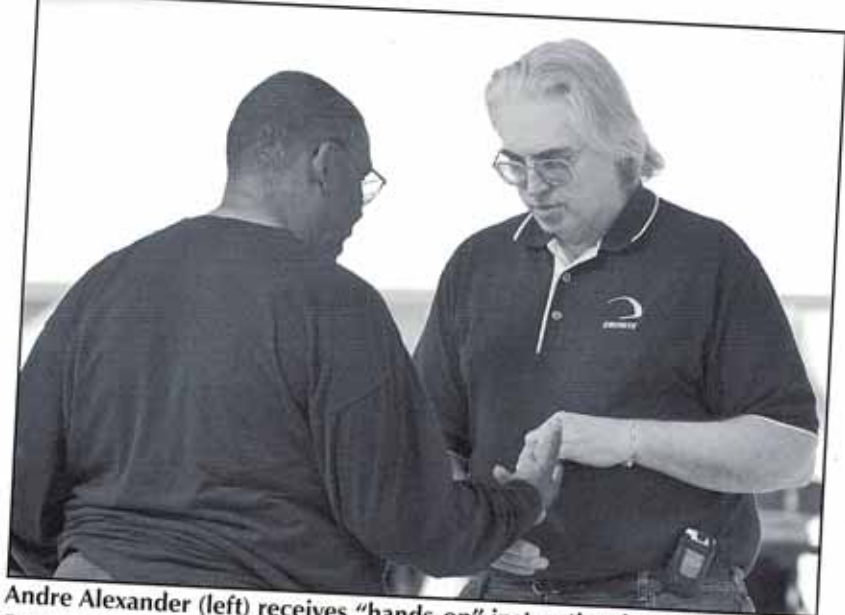




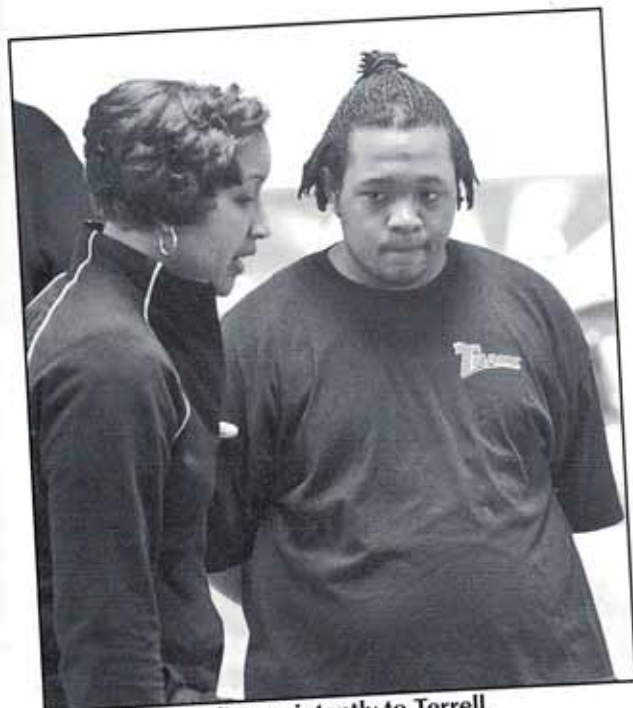
Kim Terrell helps Dominic Parham with his approach.
