

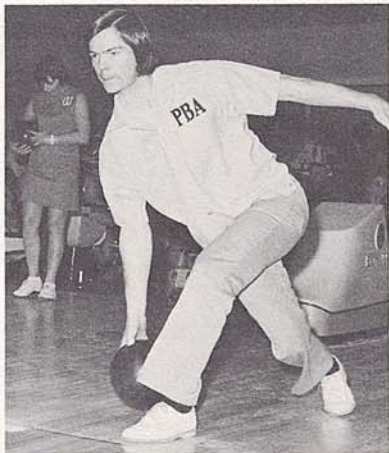
Larry O'Neill Caps Season With 300

Larry O'Neill, ranked number two in the association, ended the 1973-74 season in grand style with a perfect game.

Bowling with the "No-Gots" in the Tuesday Scratch Trio league at Bowl America Shirley, O'Neill uncorked his perfecto in the last of a 4-game series. He opened the night with a mild 166, went to a 220 in the second game, added more juice for a 231 in the third, and went all the way in the finale.
