Senior Leong Wins Mini Eliminator Opening Day Sweeper - \$5000

Terry Leong, Las Vegas, representing the 50 and over division in the Mini Eliminator's opening day Kegel Sweeper, rolled a brilliant 247 in the final shootout game to claim the \$5000 top prize. Leong started the game with a five-bagger and looked to be in total control, but a split in the 8th frame let his opponents back in the match.

Terry recovered from his mistake quickly however, then doubled in the 10th frame to secure the victory. In spite of a slow start, Jeremy Sonnenfeld, Sioux Falls, SD, reeled off a closing five-bag-

ger to finish second for \$2500 with 223.

Third and fourth was a tie between Nathan Bohr, Wichita, Kansas and International bowler Linda Haglund, from Sweden, each rolling a 215. They divided 3rd and 4th place money, earning \$1375 each. Pete Thomas, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma made a late move in the final match, but a six count on his fill ball gave him a 212 and moved him from 3rd to 5th. Thomas took home \$1000.

This first Kegel Sweeper of the 10th Anniversary drew a big field of 264 entries, playing \$20,000 in guaranteed prize money. Twenty sweeper bowlers also advanced to the \$58,000 Sweeper Grand Finale, where one of them will win a \$10,000 top prize. The Sweeper Grand Finale will be held July 8 at 7 p.m..

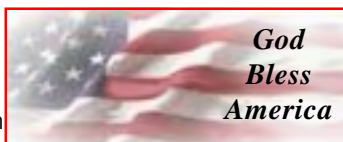
