The top senior player of the day was **Dennis Psaropoulos**, Lake Worth, Florida. Dennis rolled a fine 664 in the noon squad. The best of the after-

noon rounds for **Sustaita**, the senior was from Vista, California earned four byes Monday by rolling a great 750 series in the 4 p.m. squad to lead the day.

Lee Brosius, Centerville, Virginia with a 654 at 4 p.m. In the 205 and under division, it was a close contest for the best score of the day, with **Ken Sevitts**, Dunedin, Florida edging **Joseph Yeatts**, Denver, Colorado. Eliminator raffle prize, a new Toyota Corolla will be given away in the sweepstakes drawing.

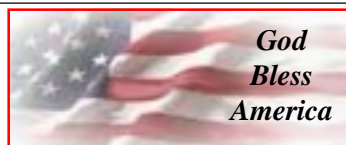
