### Haynes Hits 269 to Win \$10,000 Kegel Sweeper Grand Finale Bo Goergen Wins Car, But Opts For \$10,000 Cash In Raffle Drawing

David Haynes, Las Vegas, was near perfect in the championship game of the \$58,000 Mini Eliminator Kegel Sweeper Grand Finale. Haynes, winner of the \$5000 Saturday night sweeper, left a 10pin in his first frame and a 4 pin in the ninth - everything else was a solid strike from a far outside line on lanes 25 and 26 at the Orleans Bowling Center. He earned \$10,000 for his fantastic 269 game.

Brad Kiszewski, W. Seneca, NY put a little pressure on Haynes when he strung a six-bagger in frames 5-10, but Haynes responded by striking in the tenth to secure victory. Kiszewski earned \$5000 for his fine showing. He finished with a 245.
