FINAL EDITION Sunday, July 13, 2003 Gales Wins Mini Eliminator Senior Player wins \$50,000 Title the hard way

Ronald Gales, Las Vegas made two clutch doubles in the championship game and a miracle spare in the 10th frame to win the 2003 10th Anniversary Mini Eliminator and its \$50,000 top prize. Gales' clean 215 was enough for the victory.

In the title game, it came down to the 10th frame with two great bowlers in contention for the win - Gales and top ranked amateur Tim Mack, Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. Mack struck in frame 6-8, then left three solid ten pins in the ninth and tenth to post a 204, forcing Gales to mark in the tenth for the win. Gales stepped up on a double going for the victory, but left the very unusual 1-8 spare, a very difficult conversion amplified by the fact it was worth so much. "I just lost the ball off my hand," he said.

What happened next brought a huge roar from the large crowd pulling for Gales. He tossed the ball at the spare and thought he missed it, but the head pin, hit thin, went to the wall and it's neck clipped the back of the eight sending it falling forward. "I missed it by a mile," he said, "and on the spare, the ball didn't react, but it caught enough of it. When it went down, I knew the bowling gods were smiling on me," he said.

Mack had a good week, finishing second in two megabuck events for \$25,000 each. Tom Smallwood, Flushing, Missouri finished third for \$15,000 with a 181. Kevin Schwabe, West Allis, Wisconsin rolled a 173 for 4th and \$12,500, and 5th place went to Tom Krecskay, Winchester, Ohio for \$10,000.

The 10th Anniversary Mini Eliminator sponsored by Brunswick, drew 4011 entries and paid over a million dollars in cash and prizes. The next Mini Eliminator event will be the Super Bowl Mini Eliminator January 31- February 8, 2004 at the Gold Coast in Las Vegas.
