The Mini Eliminator Today

Former Mini Champ Atria Leads Top 8 Matchplay Players Into 'Great 48' on Sunday

Senior Division bowler and former Mini Eliminator Champion Vinnie Atria, Louisville, Kentucky is among the second group of eight players to advance to the 'Great 48' in the Mini Matchplay Tournament.

Atria survived a tough contest against Team USA star Tony Manna, Omaha, Nebraska 244-239 to make the top 16, then defeated Sweden's Mats Olsson 228-224 to make the Great Eight on lanes 11-12. Manna finished 17th to earn \$400.

On lanes 19-20 Craig Harrington, Riverton, Utah defeated 2004 Super Bowl Mini Champ Lasse Lintila of Finland 226-199 to advance. On 15-16, Joe Stillman, Staten Island, New York got by Wichita's Sean Rash 219-204.

The best game in the round of 16 was rolled by Don Fowler, Overland Park, Kansas. Fowler defeated Las Vegan John Cocci 258-183 on lanes 23-24.

In other top 16 matches, Dan Patterson, Phoenix, Arizona beat Pete Thomas, Oklahoma City 207-146, Henry Dawson, Elma, Washington defeated Bill Hoffman, Columbus, OH 224-142, Mark Siders, Columbus, Ohio defeated Bob Belmont, Las Vegas 214-151, and Paul Enright, Henderson, Nevada defeated Brad Hunter, Keller, Texas 208-186.

Sixteen players have now qualified for Friday's 'Great 48'. All sixteen will earn a minimum of \$1000 and could make as much as \$50,000 if they win the Matchplay Event and then defeat the Qualifier Tournament champion.

Matchplay Tournament Number Three will roll at 6 p.m. tonight.
