Dennis Eklund, Stockholm, Sweden put on quite a show Thursday evening in the second Lane #1 Match Play Shootout Sweeper. In his final two matches, Eklund defeated Mike Rose Jr. 290-224 and Diandra Asbaty 279-200 to claim the \$2300 top prize. Asbaty earned \$1700 as runner-up.

Both players were undefeated going into the final match, but it was Eklund who had the momentum at the end. At one point, he had 19 consecutive strikes, and struck 22 times on 24 shots in the final two matches.

The last of four sweepers in the 13th Mini drew a field of 104 entries.
