Leong and Mack Win MoRich Over and Under Doubles



Las Vegas, July 2: 500 was the magic number for Terry Leong and Tim Mack Sunday afternoon at the Orleans Bowling Center. That's the number their incredible final games added up to in the championship round of the inaugural MoRich Over and Under Doubles to kick off Mini Eliminator Week. Mack led the way with an amazing 278, with 11 strikes, leaving only the 2-8 in frame four. Leong, the senior partner in the dynamic twosome, turned in a respectable 222, rolling a clean game when it counted the most. They earned \$10,000 for their outstanding performance.

Leong and Mack's opponents in the final round were Warren Nelson and Rhino Page, who rolled a 428, and Ron Mohr and Scott Pohl, who shot 426 in the final. All three teams earned their way to the last match by winning their qualifying squads and advancing through the finals by beating half the field in each game. Nelson and Page earned \$6000 for second, and Mohr and Pohl took home \$4000.

Leong and Mack are former teammates in several tournaments, and this was the first time they have bowled together after Tim's PBA year and his well publicized shoulder injury put him on the inactive list for several months. "The shoulder feels much better now," he said. Still, just as a precaution, Mack rolled a 14 pound ball throughout the event.

"Tim's positive energy is off the chart," said Leong. "In international bowling, he's Michael Jordan, and the work he does off the lanes with kids and fans is wonderful." Mack has equal respect for Leong, who is one of the most respected senior players in the game. "I called him a couple of weeks ago, and I couldn't believe he didn't have a partner yet," said Mack. "I love bowling with Terry. He's as steady as a rock." Mack also had a new purpose for winning, as his wife, former PWBA champion Brenda (Norman) Mack, is expecting their first child. "That makes it even more exciting and meaningful," said Mack.

The inaugural MoRich Over and Under Doubles event drew a field of 85 entries and kicks off the 13th Annual Mini Eliminator Tournament, which begins today and runs through July 9th at the Orleans Bowling Center, Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas.
