

NEWCOMER, 71, SCORES PERFECTO WITH \$8 BALL

John Holland, 71, of Gainesville, Va., recently learned that you're never too old to start—and succeed—in bowling, even when using inexpensive equipment. A former director of wellness and preventative medicine at NIH who jogged with President George Herbert Walker Bush and whose cousin is Dallas Cowboys linebacker Bobby Carpenter, Dr. Holland purchased a 15-pound donated Ebonite ball for just \$8 from a program at Bowl America Bull Run that helps youth bowlers enter tournaments. Using that ball, Holland, who averages 190 and only began bowling shortly before starting his eighth decade of life, scored 300-213-202/715 on April 19 in the Monday Mixed league at the center.
