

Rich Ficken Places 3rd In ACU-I Tournament



THIRD PLACE FINISH. Rich Ficken, a freshman at the University of Maryland finished third in the finals of the 1974 Association of College Unions-International 16th annual bowling championships in Indianapolis. The field of 28 were the best of some 22,000 collegiate bowlers from over 200 colleges who participated in qualifying rounds. Ficken, a scholarship winner in last year's All America Youth Bowling Championships, rolled 577 in the singles and 588 in the doubles. A combined all-events total of 1951 for 10 games determined his third place finish.
