

LEKITES LEADS ABC SINGLES

There was another new leader in the 1982 ABC standings. **Terry Lekites**, a 26 year old intelligence technician from Alexandria, Va., opened his singles play with a 278 game and finished with a 732 set to displace Rich Wonders of Racine, Wis. by one pin.

Lekites didn't realize he was atop the standings until he had finished bowling. "I had no idea what was leading until the guys come up to me afterwards," he said. "I'm glad I didn't know too. There's enough pressure just shooting in the ABC itself. I had my lifetime high series all locked up early and was just trying to keep on striking," he added.

Lekites started striking early as he opened the first game with nine strikes. He left a 4 pin on a good hit in the 10th, spared and got nine for his 278. He added games of 222 and 232 to replace Wonders, a bowling proprietor, who shook up the standings on March 11-12.
