

## Report of Virginia State USBC April 2016 Meeting

The Annual Meeting was held at the Crowne Plaza Hampton Marina on April 16, 2016. Andrea Dale and Adam Mitchell from NCAUSBCA attended as adult delegates and Tom Dale attended as a youth delegate.

A memorial service opened the meeting as we remembered association members who passed away since the last annual meeting. They were 49 delegates in attendance.
