Report of Virginia State USBC Meeting May 2017 • Roanoke

The annual meeting was held at the Holiday Inn Tanglewood, Roanoke Va., on May 6, 2017. There were 60 delegates in attendance.

There were three USBC National representatives in attendance, David Fields, our new regional representative, Ben Brose, NE regional representative, and Richard Stewart, the new Director of Education. Presentations were made discussing the recently concluded USBC Convention, including legislation and seminars.
