





In the "Under 180" average division semifinal, Raymond Lewis leaves the 4-7 during his 248-212 loss to Taylor Davis.















Two frames after leaving a solid 7-pin (above) in the "180 & Above" average division semifinal match against Andru Blaney, Cole Middlebrooks' delivery (upper right) enters the 1-2 pocket a pinch high, and the result is an 8-pin—yet another single pin he clearly does not wish to see.







Meanwhile, Andru Blaney made all of the pins dance enough times to emerge with a 230-223 victory over Middlebrooks, earning the right to meet top seed A J Hickok for the "180 & Above" title.



Trailing by only nine pins and on a double heading into the ninth frame, Blaney had a chance to put some pressure on Hickok. However, disaster in the form of a "Big 4" split all but ended Blaney's hopes for a "T of C" victory in his home center.



On a four-bagger entering the final frame, Hickok finishes strong, scoring 29 in the tenth to post a 243-175 win over Blaney.
